Public Schools Act, 1868.

The Governing Body of Winchester College having on the 27th day of November, 1939, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the above-named Act, and of the Acts amending the same, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, made a Statute in the terms hereafter set forth, and the said Statute having this day been laid before His Majesty in Council, is hereby published in the London Gazette in accordance with the provisions in that behalf contained in the said Act.

And notice is hereby given that any person, body of persons, or body corporate, authorized in that behalf by the said Act, may, within two months after the publication of this notification, petition His Majesty in Council to withold His approval from the whole or any part of the said Statute.

WINCHESTER COLLEGE.

A STATUTE TO AMEND THE STATUTES OF THE COLLEGE CONCERNING THE FEES PAYABLE BY SCHOLARS AND THE MAXIMUM VALUE OF EXHIBITIONS AWARDABLE TO SCHOLARS.

We, the Warden and Fellows of Winchester College, being the Governing Body of Winchester College, do hereby in exercise of the powers of the Public Schools Act, 1868, and of the Acts amending the same, and of all other powers enabling us in that behalf, resolve and enact as follows:—

1. As from the commencement of this Statute, Section 10 of Statute XI, and Section 2

of Statute XII, of the Statutes of the College approved by His late Majesty King Edward the Seventh in Council on the 24th day of October, 1904, as the said sections stand amended by a Statute approved by His late Majesty King George the Fifth in Council on the 26th day of April, 1920, shall with respect to every Scholar of the College who shall be elected and admitted after the commencement of this Statute, be amended by substituting in each of the said sections, for the words "thirty guineas," the words "forty-five pounds."

- 2. The foregoing amendments made by this Statute shall not apply to nor affect any Scholar of the College who shall have been admitted or elected before the commencement of this Statute, and with respect to every such Scholar the said sections shall be read as directed by the said amending Statute approved in manner aforesaid on the 26th day of April, 1920, and as if this present Statute had not been made.
- 3. This Statute shall come into force and commence immediately upon the approval thereof by His Majesty the King in Council.
