NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE AND CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS (EMERGENCY PROVISIONS) ACT, 1939.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Emergency Provisions) Act, 1939, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, to make regulations to be entitled the National Health Insurance (Navy, Army and Air Force Auxiliary Services) Regulations, 1940;

And that, on account of urgency, the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly under section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made regulations dated December 20, 1939, and entitled the National Health Insurance (Navy, Army and Air Force Auxiliary Services) Regulations, 1939, to come into operation forthwith as provisional rules, to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of that Act;

NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT, 1936.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee,

after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred by the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, to make regulations further amending the National Health Insurance (Arrears) Regulations, 1937, as amended by the National Health Insurance (Arrears) Amendment Regulations, 1939;

And that, on account of urgency, the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, under section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made regulations dated December 29, 1939, and entitled the National Health Insurance (Arrears) Amendment Regulations (No. 2), 1939, to come into operation immediately as provisional regulations, to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of that Act;

HUDDERSFIELD.

Whereas the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses of the Borough of Huddersfield (hereinafter called the Corporation) have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order under Sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875, partially to repeal, alter or amend the Huddersfield Corporation Act, 1937, hereinafter called the "local Act", so as:—

(1) To extend until the 31st day of December, 1943, or the expiration of a period of three years from the termination of the present war (whichever may be the later) the time limited by section 16 of the local Act for the compulsory purchase of such of the lands and interests in land as the Corporation are by sections 14 and 15 of the local Act authorised to acquire but have not yet acquired for the following purposes, viz.:—

(a) the construction of the waterworks numbered 1 to 11 (inclusive) authorised by sub-section (1) of section 24 of the local Act;

(b) the construction of the subsidiary works authorised by sub-section (2) of the last mentioned section; and

(c) the protection of the aforementioned works, the other waterworks acquired by the Corporation under the local Act and for other the purposes of the water undertaking.

(2) To extend until the 31st day of December, 1950, or the expiration of a period of ten years from the termination of the present war (whichever may be the later) the time limited by section 29 of the local Act for the construction of the waterworks referred to in sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) of the immediately preceding paragraph.
