#### NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT, 1936.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (2) of section 154 of the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, to make regulations to be entitled the National Health Insurance (Unclaimed Proceeds of Stamp Sales) Amendment Regulations, 1940, to amend the National Health Insurance (Unclaimed Proceeds of Stamp Sales) Regulations, 1938.

#### EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE).

##### ROAD TRAFFIC.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him under the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, he has made The Queen's Ferry (Built-up Areas) Order, 1940, imposing a speed limit of 30 miles per hour on a section of Route A.550 at Queen's Ferry.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made an Order under Part III of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, making provision for the alteration of the boundaries of the drainage area under the jurisdiction of the South Holland Embankment Drainage Trustees, and for the reconstitution of the Trustees as the South Holland Embankment Drainage Board, and that the Order will become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament, unless within thirty-one days from the date of this Notice a Memorial praying that the Order shall not become law without confirmation by Parliament is presented to the Minister by some person or body affected by the Order and having an interest sufficient for the presentation of a Memorial.

A copy of the sealed Order has been deposited together with a copy of the map referred to therein, as amended, at the office of the Clerk of the East Elloe Rural District Council, Council Offices, Holbeach, Lincolnshire, for public inspection for a period of thirty-one days from the date of this notice, and may be inspected during the ordinary office hours.
