Order No. 5923.

FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) SPECIAL ORDER No. 18 OF 1940.

SUBJECT.

Releases the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Carlton Colville, Suffolk, from restrictions, and revokes Orders Nos. 5905, 5911 and 5920, as from the 14th February, 1940.

SUBJECT.

Authorises a special sale of pedigree pigs in Yeovil Market on the 1st March, 1940.

FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) SPECIAL ORDER No. 19 OF 1940.

SUBJECT.

Declares an Area of approximately 15 miles radius round an Infected Place at Frampton, Dorset, to be an Infected Area for the purpose of preventing the spread of foot-and-mouth disease, to which Area the provisions of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1938 are applied. The Area subject to restrictions lies in the counties of Dorset and Somerset.
