

Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly represent recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of an Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme or Representation and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order the boundaries of the said New Parish of Saint Luke, New Catton, and the said New Parish of Saint Catherine, Mile Cross, shall be altered so that (first) all those portions of the said New Parish of Saint Luke, New Catton, and of the said Parish of Hellesdon which are described in the First Schedule hereunder written and are delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto annexed and are thereon coloured pink shall be dissevered from such New Parish and Parish and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Saint Catherine, Mile Cross; and (secondly) all that portion of the said New Parish of Saint Catherine, Mile Cross, which is described in the Second Schedule hereunder written and is delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto annexed and is thereon coloured green shall be dissevered from such New Parish and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Saint Luke, New Catton:

" And we further represent, recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing, recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid or any of them in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Acts or any of them or of any other Act of Parliament.

" THE SCHEDULES to which the foregoing Scheme or Representation has reference.

" THE FIRST SCHEDULE.

" The territory to be annexed to the New Parish of Saint Catherine, Mile Cross, in the County of Norfolk and in the Diocese of Norwich, comprising:—

" 1. All that portion of the New Parish of Saint Luke, New Catton, in the said County and Diocese, which is bounded upon the west by the said New Parish of Saint Catherine, Mile Cross, upon part of the north by the Parish of Hellesdon, upon the remaining part of the north and upon the east by the Parish of Catton, both in the said County and Diocese, and upon the remaining side, that is to say, upon the south, by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said Parish of Catton from the said New Parish of Saint Luke, New Catton, at the junction of Catton Grove Road with Woodcock Road and extending thence first north-westward and then south-westward along the middle of Woodcock Road for a distance of 42 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Aylsham Road upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Luke, New Catton, from the said New Parish of Saint Catherine, Mile Cross.

" 2. And also all that contiguous portion of the said Parish of Hellesdon which is bounded upon part of the south-east by the said New Parish of Saint Catherine, Mile Cross, upon the remaining part of the south-east by the above described portion of the said New Parish of Saint Luke, New Catton, upon the east

partly by the said Parish of Catton and partly by the Parish of Saint Faith, Horsham, in the said County and Diocese, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the north and upon the west by an imaginary line commencing at a point upon the boundary which divides the said Parish of Saint Faith, Horsham, from the said Parish of Hellesdon, at the junction of Cromer Road with Holt Road and extending thence north-westward along the middle of Holt Road for a distance of $17\frac{1}{2}$ chains or thereabouts to its junction with Middleton's Lane and extending thence south-westward along the middle of Middleton's Lane for a distance of $21\frac{1}{2}$ chains or thereabouts to its junction with Reepham Road and extending thence south-eastward along the middle of Reepham Road for a distance of $26\frac{1}{2}$ chains or thereabouts to a point opposite to the wall or fence forming the boundary between the houses and premises situate upon the southern side of Links Avenue and the houses and premises situate on the northern side of Berkeley Close and extending thence south-westward to and along the said wall or fence for a distance of 30 chains or thereabouts to a point opposite to the north-western end of the wall or fence forming the eastern boundary of Hellesdon Golf Course and extending thence south-eastward to and along the last mentioned wall or fence for a distance of 33 chains or thereabouts to the point where it reaches the north-western side of Boundary Road and extending thence south-eastward for a distance of 5 yards or thereabouts to a point in the middle of Boundary Road upon the boundary which divides the said Parish of Hellesdon from the said New Parish of Saint Catherine, Mile Cross.

" THE SECOND SCHEDULE.

" The territory to be dissevered from the said New Parish of Saint Catherine, Mile Cross, and to be annexed to the said New Parish of Saint Luke, New Catton, being:—

" All that portion of the said New Parish of Saint Catherine, Mile Cross, which is bounded upon the west by the said Parish of Hellesdon, upon the south partly by the Parish of Heigham and partly by the New Parish of Saint Barnabas, Heigham, in the said County and Diocese, upon the east partly by the Parish of Saint Martin at Oak, Norwich, in the said County and Diocese and partly by the said New Parish of Saint Luke, New Catton, and upon the remaining side, that is to say, upon the north, by an imaginary line commencing at the point where the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Luke, New Catton, from the said New Parish of Saint Catherine, Mile Cross, crosses the middle of Shorncliffe Avenue and extending thence first north-westward and then south-westward along the middle of Shorncliffe Avenue for a distance of $20\frac{1}{2}$ chains or thereabouts to its junction with Drayton Road and extending thence north-westward along the middle of Drayton Road for a distance of 37 chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Catherine, Mile Cross, from the said Parish of Hellesdon."
