ARCHITECTS (REGISTRATION) ACT, 1931.

#### Amendment to Regulation 36.

Delete the words "during the years 1939 and 1940 and thereafter six shillings and eight-pence."

#### Amendment to Regulation 37.

Delete the words "for the years 1939 and 1940 respectively and thereafter six shillings and eightpence."
