

PETROLEUM (PRODUCTION) ACT, 1934.

The Board of Trade hereby give notice of the determination by the Licensee of three Prospecting Licences granted under the Petroleum (Production) Act, 1934, and the Petroleum (Production) Regulations, 1935, to the D'Arcy Exploration Co., Ltd., of Britannic House, Finsbury Circus, London, E.C.2.

The areas concerned consisted of (1) about 35 square miles in the County of Stafford, including part of the town of Stafford, (2) about 176 square miles in the Counties of Shropshire and Stafford, including the town of Market Drayton, and (3) about 58 square miles in the Counties of Derby and Chester, including the town of New Mills. In respect of area (1) which originally consisted of about 171 square miles, notice of surrender of a portion of the area consisting of about 136 square miles in the Counties of Shropshire and Stafford was published in the London Gazette on 13th December, 1938.

A description of the boundaries of the areas was published in the London Gazette on 27th April, 1937. A map showing the areas concerned may be inspected on application to the Mines Department, Dean Stanley Street, Millbank, London, S.W.1.
