RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS, 1930 TO 1936.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that he proposes after the expiry of at least forty days from this date in pursuance of the power conferred on him by the Road Traffic Acts, 1930 to 1936, to make Regulations revoking the provisions of paragraph (3) of Regulation 16 of the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations, 1937, which prescribes the conditions as to supervision and display of "L" plates under which a provisional driving licence may be granted.

And notice is hereby further given that on account of urgency the said Minister has under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Amendment) Provisional Regulations, 1940, to come into force forthwith as Provisional Regulations and to continue in force until Statutory Rules have been made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of that Act.
