

" 2. And also all that other portion of the said Parish of Saint Botolph, Cambridge, which is bounded upon all sides as follows, that is to say, upon part of the west by the Parish of Saint Mary the Less, Cambridge, in the said County and Diocese, upon the south by a detached portion of the said Parish of Saint Benedict, Cambridge, upon the east and upon part of the north by the Parish of Saint Andrew the Great, Cambridge, in the said County and Diocese, upon the remaining part of the north by another detached portion of the said Parish of Saint Benedict, Cambridge, and upon the remaining part of the west by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the last mentioned detached portion of the Parish of Saint Benedict, Cambridge, from the said Parish of Saint Botolph, Cambridge, at the junction of Downing Street and Tennis Court Road, and extending thence southward along the middle of Tennis Court Road for a distance of 3 chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said Parish of Saint Botolph, Cambridge, from the said Parish of Saint Mary the Less, Cambridge.

" 3. And also all that portion of the New Parish of Saint Paul, Cambridge, in the said County and Diocese which is bounded upon the west by the said Parish of Saint Mary the Less, Cambridge, upon the north by a detached portion of the said Parish of Saint Benedict, Cambridge, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the east and upon the south by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said detached portion of the Parish of Saint Benedict, Cambridge, from the said New Parish of Saint Paul, Cambridge, at a point in Lensfield Road opposite to the middle of Panton Street, and extending thence southward along the middle of Panton Street for a distance of 2 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Saxon Street, and extending thence westward along the middle of Saxon Street for a distance of 6 chains or thereabouts to its junction with the road called Brookside, and continuing thence westward in precisely the same direction and in a straight line for a distance of 1 chain or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Paul, Cambridge, from the said Parish of Saint Mary the Less, Cambridge.

" The Second Schedule.

" The territory to be annexed to the said Parish of Saint Botolph, Cambridge, comprising:—

" 1. All those contiguous portions of the New Parish of Saint Mark, Cambridge, and of the Parish of Saint Giles with Saint Peter, Cambridge, which taken together are bounded upon the east partly by the said Parish of Saint Botolph, Cambridge, and partly by the said Parish of Saint Mary the Less, Cambridge, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the south, upon the west, and upon the north by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said Parish of Saint Mary the Less, Cambridge, from the said New Parish of Saint Mark, Cambridge, at the junction of Church Rate Walk with the road called Summerfield, and extending thence westward along the middle of Summerfield for a distance of 10 chains or thereabouts to a point at its western

end where it reaches the wall or fence forming the eastern boundary of the premises attached to Newnham College, and extending thence first southward and then in various directions along the walls or fences forming the eastern and southern boundaries of the said premises for a distance of 22 chains or thereabouts to the point where the last mentioned wall or fence reaches the eastern side of Grange Road, and extending thence first westward to and then northward along the middle of Grange Road for a distance of $7\frac{1}{2}$ chains or thereabouts to its junction with Sidgwick Avenue, and extending thence eastward along the middle of Sidgwick Avenue (thereby following the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Mark, Cambridge, from the said Parish of Saint Giles with Saint Peter, Cambridge), for a distance of $10\frac{1}{2}$ chains or thereabouts to a point opposite to the southern end of the Corpus Christi College Sports Ground, and extending thence northward to and along the said wall or fence for a distance of 6 chains or thereabouts to the point where it meets the wall or fence forming the northern boundary of the said Sports Ground, and extending thence eastward along the last mentioned wall or fence, along the wall or fence forming the northern boundary of Corpus Christi College Garden, and along the wall or fence forming the northern boundary of the house and premises known as The Yews, for a distance in all of 15 chains or thereabouts to the point where the last mentioned wall or fence reaches the western side of Queen's Road, and extending thence in a straight line due east (thereby crossing Queen's Road) for a distance of 2 chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said Parish of Saint Giles with Saint Peter, Cambridge, from the said Parish of Saint Botolph, Cambridge.

" 2. And also all that portion of the said Parish of Saint Mary the Less, Cambridge, which lies to the west of the middle of the River Cam.

" 3. And also all that portion of the said Parish of Saint Benedict, Cambridge, which is bounded upon the south by the said Parish of Saint Botolph, Cambridge, upon the west, upon the north-west, and upon the north by the said Parish of Saint Edward, Cambridge, and upon the east by the middle of King's Parade and Trumpington Street.

" The Third Schedule.

" The territory to be annexed to the said Parish of Saint Mary the Less, Cambridge, comprising:—

" 1. All that detached portion of the said Parish of Saint Benedict, Cambridge, which lies to the south of the middle of Mill Lane and to the west of the middle of Trumpington Street.

" 2. And also all that portion of the said New Parish of Saint Paul, Cambridge, which is bounded upon the west by the said Parish of Saint Mary the Less, Cambridge, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the south, upon the east, and upon the north by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said Parish of Saint Mary the Less, Cambridge, from the said New Parish of Saint Paul, Cambridge, at a point in the middle of the eastern end of the bridge which carries Bateman Street across Hobson's Brook, and extending thence eastward along the middle of Bateman Street for a distance of 9
