The KING has been graciously pleased to ordain and declare that Ronald Orlando Lawrence Kay-Shuttleworth, Esquire, and Rosemary Florence Angela Kay-Shuttleworth, Spinster, the brother and sister of Richard Ughtred Paul Kay-Shuttleworth, Baron Shuttleworth, shall henceforth have, hold and enjoy the same title, rank, place, pre-eminence and precedence as would have been due to them had their father, Lawrence Ughtred Kay-Shuttleworth, Esquire (commonly called the Honourable Lawrence Ughtred Kay-Shuttleworth), Captain the Royal Regiment of Artillery, survived his father, Ughtred James, Baron Shuttleworth, and thereby succeeded to the title and dignity of Baron Shuttleworth.

And to command that the said Order and declaration be registered in His Majesty's College of Arms.
