

drainage authority, and of any property held by such authority for the purpose of, or in connection with, any functions so transferred.

By Part III of the Second Schedule to the said Act, it is provided that if any person aggrieved by an Order desires to question its validity on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Act, or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, he may, within six weeks after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court, and if any such application is duly made, the Court, if satisfied that the Order is not within the powers of the Act, or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.

ENNERDALE GAS.

(Application for Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts, 1920 to 1934.)

NOTICE is hereby given that application is intended to be made to the Board of Trade by the Ennerdale Rural District Council, whose address is The Council Chambers, Cleator, Cumberland (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") for a Special Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") under the Gas Undertakings Acts, 1920 to 1934, for all or some of the following purposes (that is to say):—

To extend the limits within which the Council are authorised to supply Gas (hereinafter referred to as "the existing limits") so as to include in addition to the existing limits the parish of Winscales in the Rural District of Cocker-mouth in the Administrative County of Cumberland except so much of such parish as is comprised within the limits for the supply of gas by the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Workington, hereinafter referred to as "the added limits," and to empower the Council to exercise within the added limits all or some of the rights, powers, privileges and authorities which are or may hereafter be exercisable by them in the existing limits.

To enable the Council to exercise all such powers as may be necessary or convenient for the purposes of the Order and to confer upon them all such other powers as are now usually conferred upon local authorities in connection with the supply of gas.

To vary and extinguish all rights and privileges which would or might interfere with the objects of the intended Order and to confer other rights and privileges.

To incorporate and apply with or without modification any provisions of the Land Clauses Acts, the Gasworks Clauses Acts, 1847 and

1871, and the Gas Undertakings Acts, 1920 to 1934, and to extend to the Order with or without modification all or some of the provisions of the Ennerdale Gas Order, 1939, and any other Act or Order affecting the Council or their gas undertaking.

Any local or other public authority, company or person desirous of bringing before the Board of Trade any objections to the Draft Order may do so by registered letter, addressed to the Director of Gas Administration, Board of Trade, Great George Street, London, S.W.1, and despatched on or before the 30th day of July, 1940.

Any such objections must state (a) the specific grounds of objection; and (b) the omissions, additions and modifications asked for. A copy of the objection must be forwarded to the undersigned Clerk of the Council or Parliamentary Agents at the same time as it is sent to the Board of Trade.

A copy of the Draft Special Order and an Ordnance Map showing the situation of the existing works of the Council and the boundaries of the existing and added limits have been deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the County Council of the Administrative County of Cumberland at his office at the County Offices, Carlisle, and at The Council Chambers, Cleator, and printed copies of the Draft Order may be obtained at the price of one shilling per copy at the offices of the undersigned Clerk of the Council and Parliamentary Agents.
