#### SPECIAL ENACTMENTS (EXTENSION OF TIME) ACT, 1940.

The London and North Eastern Railway Company are applying to the Minister of Transport for an Order under the Special Enactments (Extension of Time) Act, 1940, extending by three years the time now limited by Section 6 of the London and North Eastern Railway Act, 1935, for the exercise of the powers conferred upon them for the completion of the following works, namely:—

(1) Railway No. 3 in the County Borough of Ipswich authorised by the London and North Eastern Railway (Works) Act, 1930, (Section 5);

(2) Deviation Railways Nos. 1 and 2 in the Borough of Wood Green in the County of Middlesex authorised by the Great Northern Railway Act, 1914 (Section 5).
