WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the 13th and 14th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 41 ("The Parish of Manchester Division Act, 1850"), of the Act of the 29th and 30th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter III, of the Act of the 31st and 32nd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 114 ("The Ecclesiastical Commission Act, 1868"), and of the Parish of Manchester Revenues Measure, 1933, do hereby Grant to the Benefice of Saint Paul, Withington, in the
