the return journey Pilot Officer Price engaged three Messerschmitt 110's which he had observed flying above the aerodrome at Borkum. By skilful manoeuvring he enabled his rear gunner to fire bursts at one of the enemy aircraft, which appeared to be hit, and then engaged a second fighter which was shot down into the sea with its port engine on fire. Pilot Officer Price displayed great initiative and determination throughout the operation.
