LONDON AND HOME COUNTIES JOINT ELECTRICITY AUTHORITY.

ELECTION OF REPRESENTATIVES OF WORKERS IN THE INDUSTRY.

The Minister of Labour and National Service hereby gives notice that as soon as may be after the 16th day of September, 1940, he will designate to the London and Home Counties Joint Electricity Authority, in accordance with Section 2 (10) of Part I of the First Annex to the Schedule to the London and Home Counties Electricity District Order, 1925, the employees' organisations having members in the employment of authorised undertakers in the District, in order that the organisations so designated may choose two representatives of persons employed in connection with the supply of electricity in the District to be members of the Joint Authority.
