

Board of Trade Session 1940.

BANGOR GAS.

(Application for Special Order under the Gas Undertaking Acts, 1920 to 1934.)

NOTICE is hereby given that application is intended to be made to the Board of Trade by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Bangor (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") whose address is the Town Hall, Bangor, for a Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts, 1920 to 1934, for all or some of the following purposes (that is to say):—

To increase the maximum price which the Corporation may charge for gas supplied by them within their limits for the supply of gas.

To repeal, alter or amend the provisions of Section lxviii (Limit of Charge for Gas) of the Bangor Water and Gas Act 1854 and Section 4 (Maximum Price) of the Bangor Gas (Charges) Order 1929 and any other Act or Order relating to the Corporation or their Gas Undertaking.

The Order will vary or extinguish all rights and privileges which would impede or interfere with its purposes and confer other rights and privileges.

Any local or other public authority, company or person desiring to bring before the Board of Trade any objection to the draft Order may do so by registered letter addressed to the Director of Gas Administration, Board of Trade, Great George Street, London, S.W.1, and despatched on or before the 20th day of October, 1940.

Any such objection shall state:—

- (a) the specific grounds of objection; and
- (b) the omissions, additions or modifications asked for.

A copy of the objection must at the same time be forwarded to the Corporation.

Printed copies of the draft Special Order have been deposited for public inspection at the offices of the Town Clerk of the Borough of Bangor at 123, High Street, Bangor, and with the Clerk of the County Council of Caernarvon at County Offices, Caernarvon.
