## TUBERCULOSIS.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Health, after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date, and in pursuance of the powers given to him by the Public Health Act, 1936, to make regulations entitled the Public Health (Tuberculosis) Regulations, 1940, providing for the furnishing of information by medical officers of health of local authorities on requisition by the Minister of Health.

## SPECIAL ENACTMENTS (EXTENSION OF TIME) ACT, 1940.

(b) Work No. 10.—An aqueduct or line or lines of pipes as described in, and authorised by section 52 of the said Act to be constructed by the Mid-Kent Water Company; and,

(c) Work No. II.—An aqueduct or line or lines of pipes as described in and authorised by section 53 of the said Act to be constructed by the Chatham and District Water Company,

(d) Work No. 12.—An aqueduct or line or lines of pipes as described in and authorised by section 54 of the said Act to be constructed by the Higham and Hundred of Hoo Water Company.

(2) For the purposes of the Application or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on those purposes to make any such alteration or amendment of the said

Local Act, or of any other Local Act or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order in force within the limits within which the said Companies are authorised to supply water as may be necessary or desirable:

Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Special Order No. 40 of 1940.

'' Declares a dombined Area of approximately 15 miles radius round Infected Places at Wibsey, Bradford and Triangle, Halifax, Yorks. W.R., to be an Infected Area for the purpose of preventing the spread of foot-and-mouth disease, to which Area the provisions of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1938 are applied. The Area subject to restrictions lies in the counties of Chester, Lancaster and the West Riding of Yorkshire.
