ELECTRICITY (SUPPLY) ACT, 1926.

SOUTH EAST ENGLAND ELECTRICITY (ALTERA-
TION AND EXTENSION) SCHEME, 1940.

WHEREAS the Electricity Commissioners
have prepared and transmitted to the Central
Electricity Board a Scheme bearing the above

1939, by determining that a new generating
station, if and when duly authorised, will be-
come a "selected station" at which electricity
shall be generated for the purposes of the
Central Electricity Board, in addition to the
stations specified in the last-mentioned Schemes.
