Flight Lieutenant Archibald Ashmore
McKELLAR, D.F.C. (90168), Auxiliary Air
Force.

During a period of eight days in the defence
of London, Flight Lieutenant McKellar has
destroyed eight hostile aircraft, bringing his
total to twelve. He displays an excellent
fighting spirit, is a particularly brilliant tac-
tician and has led his squadron with skill
and resource.

In September, 1940, this officer carried out
a successful photographic reconnaissance of
the Dortmund-Ems aqueduct. Flying Officer
Taylor took off from his base in dense fog
but, flying through this, he reached his objec-
tive and secured valuable photographs from
a height of 6,000 feet. He has, during the
last two months, carried out a number of
exceptionally successful reconnaissances, in-
cluding one over Kiel which was considered
the most valuable reconnaissance completed
