#### SPECIAL ENACTMENTS (EXTENSION OF TIME) ACT, 1940.

Whereas the Staffordshire Potteries Water Board (hereinafter called the Board) have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of an Order under the Special Enactments (Extension of Time) Act, 1940, so as:—

(1) To extend to the 1st October, 1943, the period limited by section 18 of the Staffordshire Potteries Water Board Act, 1937, for the compulsory purchase of the lands which the Board by section 6 of this Act are authorised to acquire but have not yet acquired.

(2) For the purposes of the Application or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on those purposes to make any such alteration or amendment of the said Local Act, or of any other Local Act or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order in force within the limits within which the Board are authorised to supply water as may be necessary or desirable.
