NOTTINGHAM CORPORATION (TROLLEY VEHICLES) ORDER, 1934.

Application for an Extension of Time for the commencement of the running of Trolley Vehicles upon the route authorised by the above-named Order.

THE Lord Mayor Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Nottingham and County of the same City are applying to the Minister of Transport for an Order under the Special Enactments (Extension of Time) Act, 1940, in respect of powers conferred by section 3 of the Nottingham Corporation (Trolley Vehicles) Order, 1934 (confirmed by the Nottingham Corporation (Trolley Vehicles) Order Confirmation Act, 1934), which powers are required by sub-section (3) of that section as extended by Orders made by the Minister of Transport on the 11th day of July, 1939, and the 5th day of January, 1940, respectively to be exercised by the 12th day of January, 1941.
