RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

ROAD TRANSPORT LIGHTING ACT, 1927.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that he proposes after the expiry of at least forty days from this date in pursuance of the power conferred upon him by the Road Transport Lighting Act, 1927, to make Regulations under section 1 (3) of that Act in regard to vehicles used for naval, military or air force purposes.

And notice is hereby further given that on account of urgency the said Minister has under section 2 of the Rules Publication Act 1893, made the Road Vehicles Lighting (Special Exemption) Provisional Regulations, 1940, to come into force forthwith as Provisional Regulations and to continue in force until

Statutory Rules have been made in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of that Act.

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of Section 49(3) of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made the following Orders:—

Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas)
Special Order No. 72 of 1940.

Subject.

Extends the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Ruan Lanihorne, Cornwall, so as to include an area of approximately 15 miles radius around an Infected Place at Liskeard, Cornwall, and applies the provisions of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1938 to the Area as so extended. The whole of the Area subject to restrictions lies within the counties of Cornwall and Devon.
