the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has
made the following Orders:—

Order No. 6005.

(Dated 14th December, 1940.)

Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Special
Order No. 75 of 1940.

Subject.

Provides for the temporary modification of the
provisions of Article 8 of the Foot-and-Mouth
Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of
1938, in regard to the movement and straying of
animals grazing on Bodmin Moor and St. Clear
Downs, Cornwall, which form part of the
Infected Area declared by the Foot-and-Mouth
Disease (Infected Areas) Special Order No. 72.

Order No. 6006.

(Dated 15th December, 1940.)

Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Special
Order No. 76 of 1940.

Subject.

Extends the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected
Area around Kingsbury Episcopi, Locking and
Shepton Mallet, Somerset, and Marnhull and

Almer, Dorset, so as to include an area of
approximately 5 miles radius around an Infected
Place at Alderholt, Dorset, and applies the pro-
visions of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected
Areas Restrictions) Order of 1938 to the Area as
so extended. The whole of the Area subject to
restrictions lies within the counties of Devon,
Dorset, Somerset, Wiltshire and Hampshire.

Order No. 6007.

(Dated 17th December, 1940.)

Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Special
Order No. 77 of 1940.

Subject.

Contracts the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected
Area around Portsmouth as from 21st December,
1940, and releases the Infected Area from restric-
tions and revokes Orders Nos. 5990, 5993 and 5999
on 28th December, 1940.

Order No. 6008.

(Dated 17th December, 1940.)

Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Special
Order No. 78.

Subject.

Declares an area of approximately 15 miles
radius around an Infected Place at Sutton
Bonington, Notts, to be an Infected Area for the
purpose of preventing the spreading of foot-and-
mouth disease, to which area the provisions of the
Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restriction-
s) Order of 1938 are applied. The Area
subject to restrictions lies within the counties of
Derby, Leicester and Nottingham.
