LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

Burgh-by-Sands, Beaumont and Orton Drainage District.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made an Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, confirming the Order made on the 14th day of November, 1940, in relation to the Burgh-by-Sands, Beaumont and Orton Drainage District.

A copy of the Order may be seen at all reasonable hours at the Office of the Clerk of the Cumberland County Council, The Courts, Carlisle, until such time as a clerk is appointed to the Drainage Board, when it will be deposited at his Office, and also at the Offices of the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries, 23-25, Soho Square, London, W.1.

By Part III of the Second Schedule to the said Act, it is provided that if any person

aggrieved by an Order desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, he may, within six weeks after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court, and if any such application is duly made, the Court, if satisfied that the Order is not within the powers of the Act, or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.
