The persons whose Tenders are accepted will be informed of the same not later than the following day, and payment in full of the amounts of the accepted Tenders must be made to the Bank of England by means of Cash or a Banker's Draft on the Bank of England not later than 1.30 p.m. (Saturday 12 noon) on the day on which the relative Bills are to be dated.

7. Members of the House of Commons are not precluded from tendering for these Bills.

8. Tenders must be made on the printed forms, which may be obtained from the Chief Cashier's Office, Bank of England.

#### DANGEROUS DRUGS ACTS, 1920 TO 1932. SUSPENSION OF WITHDRAWAL OF AUTHORITIES. (AYMER DOUGLAS MAXWELL).

Whereas in pursuance of the power conferred upon the Secretary of State by Regulation 6 of the Raw Opium Regulations, 1921, as extended by the Coca Leaves and Indian Hemp Regulations, 1928, and by Regulation 7 of the Dangerous Drugs (Consolidation) Regulations, 1928, the Authorities granted by the aforesaid Regulations to duly qualified medical practitioners to be in possession of and to supply raw opium, coca leaves and Indian hemp and the drugs and preparations to which Part III of the Dangerous Drugs Act, 1920, applies, were, by notice dated the 18th October, 1935, and published in the London Gazette and Edinburgh Gazette on the 22nd October, 1935, withdrawn from Aymer Douglas Maxwell, M.B., Ch.B. (Edin.), then residing at "Kenya," Poulner Road, Ringwood, Hampshire, who had been convicted of offences against the Dangerous Drugs Acts:

And whereas at the same time a direction was given by the Secretary of State that it should not be lawful for the said Aymer

Douglas Maxwell to give prescriptions for the purposes of the Dangerous Drugs (Consolidation) Regulations, 1928.

Now therefore I hereby suspend, until further Order, the operation of the said Notice of Withdrawal and of the said direction regarding prescriptions.
