1894 TO 1937.

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of Section 49 (3) of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made the following Orders:—

Order No. 6030.

(Dated 20th January, 1941.)

Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas)
Special Order No. 12 of 1941.

Subject.

I. Contracts the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Buscot, Berks, and Luckington, Wilts, on 24th January, 1941, to an area comprising the districts situate within approximately 5 miles of Malmesbury, Wilts.

II. Releases the contracted Infected Area from restrictions and revokes Order No. 6021 on 29th January, 1941.

Order No. 6031.

(Dated 20th January, 1941.)

Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas)
Special Order No. 13 of 1941.

Subject.

I. Contracts the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Overton, Hants, and Shalbourne, Wilts, on 24th January, 1941, to an area comprising the districts situate within approximately 5 miles of Froxfield and Shalbourne, Wilts.

II. Releases the contracted Infected Area from restrictions and revokes Orders Nos. 6014 and 6022 on 30th January, 1941.

Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas)
Special Order No. 14 of 1941.

Subject.

I. Revokes Orders Nos. 6024 and 6025 and contracts the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Kingsbury Episcopi, Locking and Shepton Mallet, Somerset, and Marnhull, Almer and Alderholt, Dorset, on 24th January, 1941, so as to form two separate areas comprising (1) the districts situate within approximately 15 miles around Locking and Bleadon, Somerset, and (2) the districts situate within approximately 15 miles around Sturminster Marshall and 5 miles around Ryme Intrinseca, Dorset.

II. Contracts the Infected Area around Sturminster Marshall and Ryme Intrinseca on 26th January, 1941, to an area comprising the

districts situate within 15 miles of Sturminster Marshall.

Order No. 6033.

Subject.

Permits cattle, sheep, goats or swine shipped from Eire or Northern Ireland, except from the port of Londonderry, to be landed at the approved landing places at Birkenhead and Glasgow for the purpose of slaughter at the said landing places.

Order No. 6034.

(Dated 21st January, 1941.)

Subject.

Prohibits the landing at the approved landing place at Glasgow of cattle, sheep, goats or swine shipped from Eire, Northern Ireland or Isle of Man.

Order No. 6035.

(Dated 21st January, 1941.)

Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas)
Special Order No. 15 of 1941.

Subject.

Declares an area around Glasgow to be an Infected Area for the purpose of preventing the spreading of foot-and-mouth disease, to which area the provisions of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1938 are applied. The area subject to restrictions lies within the counties of Dunbarton, Lanark, and Renfrew.

Order No. 6036.

(Dated 24th January, 1941.)

Subject.

Prohibits the landing in Great Britain of cattle, sheep, goats or swine shipped from Eire, Northern Ireland or the Isle of Man.

Order No. 6037.

(Dated 26th January, 1941.)

Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas)
Special Order No. 16 of 1941.

Subject.

I. Declares an area comprising the districts situate within approximately 15 miles around Kington St. Michael, Wilts, to be an Infected Area for the purpose of preventing the spreading of foot-and-mouth disease, to which area the provisions of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1938 are applied. The area subject to restrictions lies within the counties of Gloucester, Somerset and Wilts, and includes the Infected Area around Malmesbury, Wilts, prescribed by Order No. 6030.

II. Revokes Orders Nos. 6021 and 6030.
