accordance with the provisions of the firstly herein mentioned Act and to his successors:

"And whereas the District hereinafter proposed to be constituted has been selected by the Bishop of Sheffield as the District for which an endowment shall be secured as provided by the above mentioned Order in Council:

'And whereas at the date of the said Order in Council the patronage of the said Benefice of Eldon, Saint Jude, was vested in Your Majesty, Your Heirs and Successors:

Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend Leslie, Bishop of Sheffield (in testimony whereof he has set his hand and Episcopal seal to this Scheme), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly recommend and propose that all those portions of the said Parish of Handsworth, of the said New Parish of Saint James, Handsworth Woodhouse, and of the said New Parish of Christ Church, Gleadless, which are described in the schedule hereunder written, all which portions, together with the boundaries thereof, delineated and set forth on the map or plan hereunto annexed, shall upon and from the day upon which any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme shall be published in the London Gazette become and be constituted a separate District for spiritual purposes by the name of 'The District of Saint Catherine, Richmond Road, Sheffield'.

"And we further recommend and propose that the whole right of Patronage of the said proposed District and when such District shall have become a New Parish then of such New Parish and the nomination of the Minister or incumbent thereof shall as provided by the said Order in Council of the 22nd day of October, 1937, be vested in and exercised by Your Majesty, Your Heirs and Successors for ever.

"And we further recommend and propose

that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid or any of them in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts or of any of them or of any other Act of Parliament.

"THE SCHEDULE to which the foregoing Scheme has reference.

"The District of Saint Catherine, Richmond

Road, Sheffield, being: -

" All those contiguous portions of the Parish of Handsworth, of the New Parish (sometime District Chapelry) of Saint James, Handsworth Woodhouse, and of the New Parish (sometime District Chapelry) of Christ Church, Gleadless, all in the County of York and in the Diocese of Sheffield, which taken together are bounded on all sides as follows, that is to say, upon a part of the north-west by the New Parish of Saint Swithun, Sheffield, in the said County and Diocese and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the remaining part of the northwest, upon the north-east, upon the east, upon the south and upon the south-west by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Swithun, Sheffield, from the said Parish of Handsworth at a point in the middle of the footpath leading from Beaumont Road to the southern end of Bowden Housteads Wood and extending thence north-eastward along the middle of that footpath for a distance of 13½

chains or thereabouts to its junction with the footpath leading across Richmond Road and Shirtcliff Brook to Stradbroke Road and extending thence generally south-eastward along the middle of the last mentioned footpath (thereby following in part the boundary which divides the said Parish of Handsworth from the said New Parish of Saint James, Handsworth Woodhouse) for a distance of 1 mile 11½ chains or thereabouts to the northern side of Stradbroke Road and extending thence southward to and eastward along the middle of Stradbroke Road for a distance of 5 chains or thereabouts to a point opposite the middle of the footpath leading to Wolverley Road and extending thence due southward in a straight line for a distance of 3 chains and extending thence westward in a line parallel to and distant 3 chains precisely from the middle of Stradbroke Road for a distance of 25 chains or thereabouts to the wall or fence forming the eastern boundary of the close numbered I upon the map or plan annexed to this Scheme and extending thence first southward and then westward along the said wall or fence and along the wall or fence forming the southern boundary of the said close for a distance in all of 8 chains or thereabouts to the junction of the last mentioned wall or fence with the wall or fence forming the eastern boundary of the Normanton Spring Welfare Club Sports Ground and extending thence southward along the last mentioned wall or fence and in a straight line in continuation thereof across the Woodhouse Junction and Birley Collieries Line of the London and North Eastern Railway for a distance of 81 chains or thereabouts to the northern end of the wall or fence forming the western boundary of the houses and premises situate on the western side of Haxby Street and extending thence southward along the last mentioned wall or fence for a distance of 4 chains or thereabouts to the northern side of Normanton Spring Road and extending thence generally southward across the last mentioned road and along the footpath leading to the Wickfield Plantation for a distance of 6 chains or thereabouts to the point where the said footpath is crossed by the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint James, Handsworth Woodhouse from the Parish of Beighton in the County of Derby and in the Diocese of Derby and extending thence generally westward along the last mentioned boundary for a distance of $45\frac{1}{2}$ chains or thereabouts to the point where the boundaries of the last mentioned New Parish and Parish and of the said New Parish of Christ Church, Gleadless, all meet and extending thence north-westward along the middle of Mansfield Road (thereby following in part the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Christ Church, Gleadless, from the said New Parish of Saint James, Handsworth Woodhouse) for a distance of 60½ chains or thereabouts to the point where the boundaries of the New Parish of Saint Swithun, Sheffield, of the New Parish of Saint Paul, Arbourthorne, Sheffield, both in the said County of York and in the said Diocese of Sheffield, and of the said New Parish of Christ Church, Gleadless, all
