AIR FORCE ACT.

It is proposed to amend the Rules of Procedure (Air Force) 1933, made under section 70 of the Air Force Act.

The Secretary of State for India has appointed Mr. Robert Tulip Coates, a Departmental Clerical Officer of Customs and Excise at Dundee, who also holds an appointment as a Deputy Superintendent at West Hartlepool, to superintend the transfer of lascars or other persons, and to grant the certificate required under section 125 of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1894 (57 and 58 Vic. cap. 60).

The fee to be paid for every lascar, or other person, in respect of whom such certificate is applied for, is limited to three shillings and in no case is the total amount of fees in respect of one crew to exceed five pounds.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him under Section 4 (3) of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, proposes to make Orders confirming the Schemes submitted to him by the East Norfolk Rivers (including the River Waveney) Catchment Board, under Section 4 (1) (b) of the Act, making provision for the following matters:—

(1) The constitution of the Lower Yare First Internal Drainage District and of a Drainage Board therefor.

(2) The constitution of the Lower Yare Second Internal Drainage District and of a Drainage Board therefor, the abrogation of

the powers of the Chet Valley Commissioners of Sewers so far as such powers are exercisable within the said Internal Drainage District, and the abolition of the Claxton and Rockland Drainage Board.

(3) The constitution of the Lower Yare Third Internal Drainage District and of a Drainage Board therefor, and the abolition of the Raveningham Norton Subcourse and Thurlton Drainage Commission, the Thurlton Haddiscoe and Thorpe-next-Haddiscoe Drainage Commission, and the Norton Subcourse Drainage Commission, and the abrogation of the powers of the Chet Valley Commissioners of Sewers so far as such powers are exercisable within the said Internal Drainage District.

(4) The constitution of the Lower Yare Fourth Internal Drainage District and of a Drainage Board therefor and the abolition of the Cantley and Haddingham Drainage Commission.

(5) The constitution of the Lower Waveney Second Internal Drainage District and of a Drainage Board therefor and the abolition of the Haddiscoe Thorpe-next-Haddiscoe and Aldeby Drainage Board and the Burgh of St. Peter Drainage Board.

(6) The constitution of the Lower Waveney Third Internal Drainage District and of a Drainage Board therefor.

(7) Certain matters supplemental to the above provisions.
