EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE).

THE PETROLEUM ORDER, 1941.

The Board of Trade hereby gives notice that in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, they have revoked The Petroleum (No. 1) Order, 1940, and have replaced it by The Petroleum Order, 1941. The revocation of the earlier, and the operation of the new, Order take effect on the 25th April.

The Petroleum Order, 1941, continues the requirement that persons engaged in the acquisition and disposal of petroleum and allied products must obtain a licence, but provision is made in the new Order for excluding the smaller trader from the licensing system. The Order trader from the licensing system. also contains powers for controlling the consumption by burning of liquid fuel.
