Notice is hereby given in pursuance of Section 49 (3) of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made the following Orders:—

Order No. 6141.

(Dated 4th June, 1941.)

Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas)
Special Order No. 101 of 1941.

Subject.

I. Contracts the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Carlisle, on 10th June, 1941, to an area comprising the districts situate within approximately 5 miles of that place.

II. Releases the contracted Infected Area from restrictions and revokes Order No. 6131 on 17th June, 1941.

Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas)
Special Order No. 102 of 1941.

Subject.

I. Contracts the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Cleveleys, Pilling, Rawtenstall and Urmston, Lancashire, so as to form three areas comprising the districts situate within approximately 5 miles of (a) Cleveleys and Pilling, Lancashire, (b) Urmston, Lancashire, and (c) Rawtenstall, Altham and Whitworth, Lancashire.

II. Releases the contracted Infected Areas (a) and (b) on 12th and 15th June, 1941, respectively, and releases the contracted Infected Area around Rawtenstall, Altham and Whitworth, Lancashire, and revokes Order No. 6129 on 17th June, 1941.

Subject.

Substitutes the following paragraph for the last paragraph of the First Schedule to the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Special Order No. 99 of 1941:—

“ The parishes of Terregles and Trogueur; and so much of the parish of Lochrutton as lies to the east of the road running from Seaside via Drumnore, Lochside and Foreside to Woodhead.”

Subject.

I. Contracts the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Ayr and Stewarton, Ayrshire, Ouplaymoor, Renfrewshire, and Carluke, Lanarkshire, on 13th June, 1941, so as to form two areas comprising the districts situate within approximately 5 miles of (a) Carluke, Lanarkshire, and (b) Kilbarchan and Paisley, Renfrewshire.

II. Releases the contracted Infected Area around Carluke, Lanarkshire, from restrictions on 17th June, 1941.

III. Releases the contracted Infected Area around Kilbarchan and Paisley, Renfrewshire, from restrictions and revokes Order No. 6133 on 19th June, 1941.

II. Releases the contracted Infected Area from restrictions and revokes Order No. 6134 on 18th June, 1941.
