Acting Squadron Leader Peter Henry Anker SIMMONS. D.F.C. (39671), No. Squadron.

In June, 1941, this officer participated in an operational sweep against enemy shipping off the Dutch coast. Undeterred by extremely bad flying conditions, he eventually led his flight in a low level attack on an enemy convoy. In spite of fierce and accurate anti-aircraft fire, he succeeded in obtaining 2 direct hits on a vessel of 5,000 tons while another member of his flight also scored hits on a vessel of similar size. Both ships were destroyed. Earlier in May, Squadron Leader Simmons executed a highly successful operation over Heligoland with magnificent dash. He has at all times shown outstanding leadership and courage.
