Aircraftman Clifton felt the aircraft lurch and looking forward saw the observer trying to regain control. He immediately scrambled forward and assisted by the observer, succeeded in removing the pilot from his seat. Aircraftman Although Clifton had not received any flying training, he took over the controls and flew the aircraft back to his base where he accomplished a safe landing at the third attempt, without dam-age to the aircraft. This airman displayed great courage and resource.
