WANDSWORTH AND DISTRICT GAS (EXTENSION OF TIME) ORDER, 1941.

UNDER the Special Enactments (Extension of Time) Act 1940 the Board of Trade have made an Order extending by three years the time limited by Section 18 of the Wandsworth and District Gas Act 1937 for the promotion by the Wandsworth and District Gas Company of a Bill in Parliament proposing a revision of the basic price fixed by the Wandsworth Wimbledon and Epsom District Gas Act 1929 or giving an opportunity for such revision to be made.
