

NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT,
1936.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred by the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, to make regulations to be entitled the National Health Insurance (Approved Societies) Amendment Regulations (No. 2), 1941;

And that, on account of urgency, the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, under section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made regulations dated 12th September, 1941, and entitled the National Health Insurance (Approved Societies) Amendment Regulations (No. 2), 1941, to come into operation forthwith as provisional rules and to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of that Act.

Under the Special Enactments (Extension of Time) Act, 1940, the Electricity Commissioners have made an Order entitled the Hipperholme Electricity (Extension of Purchase Date) Order, 1941, extending for three years the period of 35 years (expiring 11th June, 1943) at the expiration of which by not more than twenty-four nor less than twelve calendar months' previous notice the Corporation of Brighouse, under the terms of a Deed dated 11th June, 1908, may require the transfer to them of the electricity undertaking of the Electrical Distribution of Yorkshire Limited authorised by the Hipperholme Electric Lighting Orders, 1905 and 1907. Under the Special Enactments (Extension of Time) Act, 1940, the Electricity Commissioners have made an Order entitled the New Sarum Electricity (Extension of Purchase Date) (No. 2) Order, 1941, extending for a further period of one year the period which was extended to 6th July, 1941, by the New Sarum Electricity (Extension of Purchase Date) Order, 1941 (made by the Commissioners on 6th January, 1941), within six months after the expiration of which the Corporation of New Sarum may, by virtue of Section 3 of the New Sarum (Amendment) Special Order, 1937, exercise the right conferred on them by Section 2 of the Electric

Lighting Act, 1888, to purchase the electricity undertaking authorised by the Salisbury Electric Lighting Order, 1895.
