Office of the High Commissioner for India.

The Secretary of State for India has appointed Mr. Alfred William Hagen a Deputy Superintendent in the Mercantile Marine Office, Avonmouth, to superintend the transfer of lascars or other persons, and to grant the certificate required under section 125 of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1894 (57 and 58 Vic., cap. 60).

The fee to be paid for every lascar, or other person, in respect of whom such certificate is applied for, is limited to three shillings and in no case is the total amount of fees in respect of one crew to exceed five pounds.
