an attack on a Chemical works at Nantes. On nearing the target area, an enemy fighter was evaded. Sergeant Morgan again approached the target and, after overcoming many difficulties, finally succeeded in releasing his stick of bombs on the objective from a low altitude. Bursts were observed and explosions rocked the aircraft violently. The persistence and skill with which Sergeant

Morgan carried out these attacks enabled the targets to be effectively bombed and ensured the safety of his aircraft.

As an observer air gunner Sergeant Rix has assisted in the destruction of 3 enemy aircraft within 3 nights. He has shown great skill and determination.
