Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas)  
Special Order No. 116 of 1941.

I. Contracts the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Hayne Barton, Cullompton, Devon, on 17th November, 1941, to an area comprising the districts situate within approximately 5 miles of Hayne Barton.

II. Releases such contracted Infected Area from restrictions on 24th November, 1941.

Animals (Landing from Eire, Northern Ireland and Isle of Man) (Amendment) Order of 1941 (No. 12).

I. Revokes the Animals (Landing from Eire, Northern Ireland and Isle of Man) (Amendment) Orders of 1941 (Nos. 4 and 11) on 24th November, 1941.

II. Allows the importation at approved landing places in Great Britain, on and after the 24th November, 1941, of cattle, sheep, goats or swine, brought from Eire, Northern Ireland or the Isle of Man, in accordance with the provisions of the Animals (Landing from Ireland, Channel Islands and Isle of Man) Order of 1933, as amended by the Orders of the
