**NOTIFICATION OF A STATE OF WAR  
 WITH THAILAND.**

His Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom have been informed by the Swiss Government, who are in charge of British interests in Thailand, that a letter was addressed to the Swiss Consul at Bangkok on the 25th January by the Thai Ministry of Foreign Affairs stating that a declaration of war on Great

Britain had been made as from noon of the 25th January, 2485 Buddhist Era (5 a.m. Greenwich Mean Time, 25th January, 1942).

In consequence of this act of the Thai Government a state of war now exists between the two countries.
