WIDOWS', ORPHANS' AND OLD AGE CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS ACTS, 1936 TO 1941.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Minister

of Health, acting jointly after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Acts, 1936 to 1941, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, to make regulations to be entitled the Contributory Pensions (Emergency Provisions) Regulations, 1942;

And that, on account of urgency, the National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Minister of Health, acting jointly under section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made regulations dated February 27, 1942, and entitled the Contributory Pensions (Emergency Provisions) Regulations, 1942, to come into operation immediately as provisional rules and to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of that Act

CITY OF CHESTER.

Appointment of Adjudicating Officers.

103.285. (28th March, 1942)

Whereas it is expedient that the Council of the City of Chester (which Council and City are in this Order referred to as "the Council" and "the City" respectively) should be empowered to appoint Officers to be termed Adjudicating Officers to perform duties under the Poor Law Acts, 1930 to 1938, relating to the grant of relief and the reimbursement of the Council of the amount of any relief expended on their behalf:

Now therefore the Minister of Health, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by the Poor Law Act, 1930, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order.

Citation, &c.

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Chester (Adjudicating Officers) Order, 1942, and in its application to the City shall be read as one with the Public Assistance Order, 1930, as amended by the Public Assistance (Casual Poor) Order, 1931, as subsequently amended, the Public Assistance (Amendment) Order, 1939, the Public Assistance (Amendment) Order, 1940, the Public Assistance (Amendment) Order (No. 2), 1940, and the Public Assistance (Amendment) Order, 1941, and modified by this Order:

Provided that in case of any inconsistency the provisions of this Order shall prevail.

(2) This Order shall come into operation on the 20th day of April, 1942.

Modification of Orders, &c, Applicable to the City.

2.—(1) Any orders, rules or regulations made by the Minister and in force in the City shall, in their application to the City, have effect subject to such modifications as may be necessary to give full effect to the provisions of this Order.

(2) Notwithstanding the generality of the provisions of paragraph (1) of this Article the Public Assistance Order, 1930, as amended as hereinbefore set out shall in its application to the City be modified in manner following, namely:—

(a) in paragraph (1) (b) of Article 25, before the words "a Relieving Officer", there shall be inserted the words "an Adjudicating Officer or";

(b) in paragraph (5) of Article 166, after the words "the Council", wherever those words occur, there shall be inserted the words "or an Adjudicating Officer", and after the words "when required by them" there shall be inserted the words "or him";

(c) to paragraph (1) of Article 167 there shall be added the words "and shall also attend before any Adjudicating Officer when that Officer is considering applications for relief reported to him by the Relieving Officer";

(d) in paragraph (4) of Article 167, after the word "Committee", there shall be inserted the words "and each attendance before any Adjudicating Officer";
