In February, 1942, this airman was a member of a machine gun crew on board a transport which was subjected to a series of dive-bombing attacks covering a period of 4 hours. He used his gun with great skill, and his courageous and determined example inspired his fellow gunners so that, after the first attack, the enemy aircraft kept at a respectful distance a fact which undoubtedly assisted in the eventual safety of the ship. During the attack, Aircraftman Cottrill shot down an enemy aircraft.
