ROYAL AIR FORCE.

The KING has been graciously pleased to approve the following awards in recognition of gallantry displayed in flying operations against the enemy:—

Bar to Distinguished Flying Cross.

Squadron Leader William Winder McCONNELL, D.F.C. (81643), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 23 Squadron.

Since being awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross Squadron Leader McConnell has led his squadron in a number of successful offensive operations which have included attacks against enemy shipping, docks and aerodromes. He also participated with distinction in the combined operations at Dieppe on 19th August, 1942. Squadron Leader McConnell has consistently displayed gallantry and devotion to duty of a high order, whilst his leadership has been an example to others.

Squadron Leader Peter Reginald Whalley WICKHAM, D.F.C. (33403), No. 111 Squadron.

This officer who has led his squadron in a large number of operational sorties, has displayed outstanding leadership, skill and initiative. During the combined operations at Dieppe on 19th August, 1942, Squadron Leader Wickham led his squadron in the first sortie before dawn and in a further four during the same operations. He has personally destroyed 9 enemy aircraft, probably destroyed 5 and damaged several others.

Bar to Distinguished Flying Cross.

Flight Lieutenant Douglas Alfred George PARRY, D.F.C. (79162), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 105 Squadron.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Pilot Officer Victor George ROBSON (116437), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 105 Squadron.

In August, 1942, Flight Lieutenant Parry and Pilot Officer Robson were pilot and navigator respectively of an aircraft detailed to attack a target in Germany in daylight. In spite of difficulties, and in the face of intense anti-aircraft fire, the target, which was comparatively small, was vigorously attacked from a low level and hits were made. Throughout, Flight Lieutenant Parry and Pilot Officer Robson, whose skilful navigation was of the greatest assistance, displayed great courage and determination to achieve success. Both these officers have completed numerous sorties.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Wing Commander Humphrey Petre JENKINS (26234), No. 31 Squadron.

During the operations in Burma and the Far East, this officer displayed inspiring leadership especially during the evacuation and when

dropping supplies. His devotion to duty has been outstanding.

Acting Wing Commander William Hawkesley BURBURY, A.F.C. (19201), No. 31 Squadron.

In the operations in Burma and Assam this officer carried out a large number of hours flying in the face of great difficulties. Throughout, he set an inspiring example to all under his command.

Squadron Leader Kenneth Frederick MACKIE (33195), No. 31 Squadron.

During the operations in Burma, this officer performed much valuable work, especially in the dropping of supplies and during the evacuation. On one occasion, he courageously landed his aircraft on rough ground and rescued 23 persons from Fort Hertz.

Acting Squadron Leader Norman Hobson BRETZ (Can/J.2975), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 402 Squadron.

Squadron Leader Bretz has completed many operational sorties including 4 low level raids in Hurricane bombers as a result of which 2 enemy destroyers were severely damaged. During the combined operations at Dieppe on August 19th, 1942, he led his squadron in 4 sorties and destroyed 1 enemy aircraft and damaged another. Squadron Leader Bretz has displayed great courage and initiative which have contributed largely to the successes achieved by his squadron.

Acting Squadron Leader Lloyd Vernon CHADBURN (Can/J.2976), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 416 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron.

This officer has led his squadron with great skill. During the combined operations at Dieppe on August 19th, 1942, the squadron destroyed 3 enemy aircraft, probably destroyed 1 and damaged 7 others without loss to themselves. This achievement reflects the greatest credit on this officer's excellent leadership and he has inspired confidence in those under his command. He has personally destroyed 1 enemy "E" boat, and has probably destroyed a Junkers 88 and damaged other enemy ships and aircraft.

Acting Squadron Leader Patrick Bernard George DAVIES (85937), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 19 Squadron.

This officer has participated in sorties over enemy occupied territory as well as in several attacks on shipping. On one occasion, in March, 1942, he led a formation as escort to a force of bombers detailed to attack the aerodrome at Abbeville. Some 30 enemy fighters attempted to intercept the bombers but their efforts were frustrated. Squadron Leader Davies, displaying extremely skilful leadership, contributed materially to the success achieved. In the combined operations at Dieppe on 19th August, 1942, his fine qualities were well to the fore. Squadron Leader Davies has destroyed at least 2 enemy aircraft.

Acting Squadron Leader Denis Graham SMALLWOOD (40645), No. 87 Squadron.

This officer is an exceptionally keen and skilful pilot who has rendered excellent service, especially in night flying operations. In the recent combined operations at Dieppe, Squadron Leader Smallwood led his squadron on two low level attacks on gun emplacements in the face of strong opposition from the ground defences; his leadership proved a valuable asset. By his personal example, he has contributed materially to the high standard of morale and efficiency of his squadron.

Acting Squadron Leader Edward Roland THORN, D.F.M. (46957), No. 32 Squadron.

Squadron Leader Thorn, by his personal example and untiring energy, has built his squadron into a highly efficient unit during the five months in which he has been its commanding officer. During the combined operations at Dieppe on 19th August, 1942, he displayed great courage and determination when under heavy fire from the ground defences and he refused to be diverted from his task when warned that he was being attacked by an enemy fighter. The successes achieved by the squadron on this and other occasions have been primarily due to Squadron Leader Thorn's gallantry and fine leadership both in the air and on the ground.

Flight Lieutenant Ivor Herbert EDWARDS (78979), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 19 Squadron.

This officer has completed numerous sorties over enemy occupied territory. He is a skilful and determined leader whose confidence has set an inspiring example. He has destroyed at least two enemy aircraft and damaged several more. Flight Lieutenant Edwards participated with distinction in the recent combined operations at Dieppe.

Flight Lieutenant William GILMOUR (42214), No. 156 Squadron.

One night in August, 1942, this officer was captain of the leading aircraft of a bomber force detailed to attack an objective at Kassel. Despite heavy anti-aircraft fire, Flight Lieutenant Gilmour eventually identified his correct target over which he released his flares with such accuracy that all following aircraft were enabled to bomb their objective successfully. Although his aircraft was badly damaged, Flight Lieutenant Gilmour flew it back to base. By his tenacity and skill, this officer contributed much to the success achieved. He has participated in numerous sorties and has invariably displayed high qualities of leadership and determination.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Leslie, Dennis BRITAIN (85704), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 25 Squadron.

Flight Lieutenant Britain is an observer of outstanding merit who has assisted in the destruction of 5 enemy aircraft at night. He has also helped considerably in the training of other observers, to whom he has set an excellent example.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Selden Raymond EDNER (64860), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 121 (Eagle) Squadron.

This officer has participated in many operational sorties and has destroyed at least 5 enemy aircraft, a locomotive, and 3 barges. Flight Lieutenant Edner is a fine leader whose skill and determination have greatly inspired other members of his flight.

Acting Flight Lieutenant John SHEPHERD (104447), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 118 Squadron.

This officer has taken part in many sorties over enemy-occupied territory and in several reconnaissance missions and attacks on shipping. He has destroyed at least 2 enemy aircraft. In the combined operations at Dieppe, Flight Lieutenant Shepherd assisted in the destruction of a Dornier 217. He has at all times displayed great skill and determination.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Herbert Edward TAPPIN (89304), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 3 Squadron.

Flight Lieutenant Tappin who was appointed flight commander in April, 1942, has participated in a number of hazardous operations. He led his squadron in the first sortie during the combined operations at Dieppe, on 19th August, 1942, and although his aircraft was severely damaged, he returned to base safely. Flight Lieutenant Tappin led the squadron in a further three sorties during

these operations and despite the fierce enemy opposition he pressed home his attacks. He has displayed courage and devotion to duty of a high standard.

Flying Officer Jack HENDERSON (106193), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 19 Squadron.

This officer has participated in numerous sorties over enemy-occupied territory in several shipping reconnaissances and took part in the combined operations at Dieppe. Throughout, he has displayed coolness and determination. He has destroyed 1 and probably another 2 hostile aircraft.

Pilot Officer Frank Thorburn BROWN (121082), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 118 Squadron.

This officer has participated in a large number of operational sorties. He has invariably led his section with outstanding ability and has set an example which has done much to maintain the high morale of his fellow pilots.

Pilot Officer Robin John McNAIR (112522), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 87 Squadron.

This officer is a most capable operational pilot. In night-flying operations, he has destroyed a Heinkel 111 and probably destroyed 2 Junkers 88's. In the combined operations at Dieppe, his cool and courageous work set an inspiring example.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

1257831 Flight Sergeant John William BROOKS, No. 174 Squadron.

Flight Sergeant Brooks has completed 32 operational sorties. These operations have included high and low level raids and dive bombing attacks against industrial installations, aerodromes and sea ports. He also participated in the combined operations at Dieppe on 19th August, 1942. Flight Sergeant Brooks has at all times pressed home his attacks with great courage and determination and has proved himself to be a skilful section leader.

Can./R. 67165 Flight Sergeant Guy Philip ALDRICH YATES, Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 40 Squadron.

One night in August, 1942, Flight Sergeant Yates captained an aircraft detailed to attack shipping in Tobruk harbour. On the outward flight, when some 60 miles from the target, serious engine trouble developed. Despite this, he flew on and released his bombs alongside the jetties where a large explosion occurred. On the return journey engine trouble continued, and one of the propellers dropped off. The aircraft rapidly lost height and, although movable equipment was jettisoned, it was not possible to regain height. After ordering his crew to abandon the aircraft by parachute, Flight Sergeant Yates flew on alone. Presently the engines ceased entirely and he was forced to leave by parachute. Throughout this airman displayed great skill and courage, while his efforts to save his aircraft were worthy of high praise.

Can./R. 76955 Sergeant Ronald George BELL, Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 408 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron.

One night in August, 1942, this airman was pilot of an aircraft detailed to attack Duisburg. Whilst over the target area his aircraft was attacked by an enemy fighter from close range. Diving steeply, Sergeant Bell evaded further attacks but his aircraft had sustained extensive damage. The elevators, the port aileron and fuselage were all pierced; the port petrol tanks were riddled, while the hydraulics were shot away and one of the gun cupolas was smashed. The first wireless operator was injured and Sergeant Bell was badly cut in the right hand by splinters. Despite this, he made another run over the target and bombed it. Shortly after leaving the target area one of the engines failed and the aircraft spun towards the ground. Sergeant Bell, however, skilfully regained control and eventually flew his damaged bomber back to an aerodrome in this country where he executed a skilful crash-landing. In the face of harassing circumstances, this airman displayed great courage and devotion to duty.
