

Month. The Elector of Brandenburg's Commissioners, who are to deliver this City to the Polanders, arrived there this week, and the Castellain *Wratzlewsky* and the Starost *Visky*, whom the Senate of Poland have nominated as Commissioners from the King and Republick to receive the same, are come to *Mariembourg*. General *Greiben* being appointed Governor of *Elbing*, is come into the Neighbourhood of that Place with his Regiment, which is to remain in Garrison there.

Vienna, Jan. 28 N.S. Great Preparations are making here for the Publick Entry of the *Turkish* Anibassador, who in the mean time continues at *Schwet*, about a mile from this Place. The *Sieur Gmolinsky* Bishop of *Cujavia*, and Envoy Extraordinary from the King of *Poland*, has had his Audience of Leave of the Emperor, and will begin his Journey to *Rome* in a day or two. It's discoursed here, that the King of the *Romans* will be crowned King of *Bohemia* at *Prague* next Spring. The Commissaries of the Imperial Forces in *Hungary* are ordered to repair hither, to lay before the Council of War an exact List of the said Forces, in order to have the necessary Provision made for their Pay and Subsistence. The States of the *Lower-Austria* continue assembled in this City, and intend to give the Emperor a Subsidy of 700000 Florins for his present Occasions.

Bristol, Febr. 5. Yesterday came in here the *Olive-Tree* of this Place, *Richard Symes* Commander, from *Cadiz*, and the *Samuel, William Bayly* Master, from *Watersford*. We have an Account, that the *Mary* of *London*, bound home from the *East-Indies*, is come to an Anchor on *Ely Oaze*, near *Cardiff*.

Deale, Febr. 6. There are lately arrived in the Downs the *Thomas*, Capt. *Pye*, from the *East-Indies*; the *Canterbury*, Capt. *Read*, from the *Streights*; the *Exchange*, Capt. *Skew*, from *Leghorne*; the *Mary*, Capt. *Martin*, and the *Unity*, Capt. *Myers*, from *Leghorne*; and the *Catherine*, Capt. *Stevens*, from *Barcelona*; The *Limpo*, Capt. *Frank*, bound to the *East-Indies*, and divers other outward-bound Merchant Ships, are come down the River.

Whitehall, Febr. 6. This being the Princess of *Denmark's* Birth-day, His Majesty came to *St. James's* to visit her Royal Highness. There was a great Appearance of Persons of Quality to Compliment her Royal Highness on this occasion; And in the evening the Duke of *Glocester* had a Firework.

By the Commissioners for Managing the Collection of Six Pence a Month out of the Seamen's Wages, for the Use of *Greenwich Hospital*.

Whereas the Masters of Divers Merchant Ships and Vessels, do delay the Payment of the Six Pence a Month, due by them out of their Seamen's Wages for the Use of *Greenwich Hospital*; some detaining the same in their Hands till they are ready to go upon a Second Voyage: And others, for a considerable time after they have left their Ships or Vessels, and New Masters are in their Places, who know not of the said Arrear; which is not only a great disadvantage to the Hospital, but the Occasion of much Trouble to the succeeding Masters, whose Ships are stopp'd from proceeding to Sea for his Neglect; as also to such Merchants, Owners or others, as are concerned in the said Ships.

These are therefore (for preventing the said Inconveniencies) to give Notice to all Owners, Masters, and others concerned, That those who are in Arrear at this time, and shall not appear and pay the same at the respective Offices appointed for receiving thereof, on, or before the 29th of February instant, will be forthwith Prosecuted for their Contempt, as directed by Act of Parliament, and that from and after the 29th Day of this Month, All such Masters, as shall Neglect to make the said Payments within the space of Fewteen Days after their respective Ships and

Vessels shall be Cleared inward by the Officers of His Majesty's Customs at the several Ports, shall be likewise Prosecuted as aforesaid. Dated at the Receivers-Office this 6th of February, 1699.
