The KING has been graciously pleased to approve the following awards in recognition of gallantry displayed in flying operations against the enemy:—

Distinguished Service Order.

Acting Squadron Leader Douglas Alfred George PARRY, D.F.C. (79162), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 105 Squadron.

On 25th September, 1942, this officer led a formation of bombers detailed to attack the Gestapo Headquarters on the occasion of the Quisling Rally at Oslo. On reaching the city, Squadron Leader Parry vigorously attacked his objective from roof-top height and obtained hits on the centre of the buildings despite interference by enemy fighters. Throughout the flight, which demanded a high degree of skill, Squadron Leader Parry displayed great leadership.

Distinguished Service Order.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Joseph Roy George RALSTON, D.F.M. (47650), No. 105 Squadron.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Warrant Officer James Lloyd ARMITAGE (936476), No. 139 Squadron.

In September, 1942, Flight Lieutenant Ralston and Warrant Officer Armitage were pilot and observer respectively of one of a formation of bomber aircraft detailed to attack a factory at Wiesbaden. The sortie involved a flight deep into German territory in daylight. Nevertheless, the objective was reached exactly as planned and subjected to vigorous bombing, hits being obtained. Throughout the sortie, both Flight Lieutenant Ralston and Warrant Officer Armitage displayed exceptional skill and determination. Both of them have completed many sorties.

Bar to Distinguished Flying Cross.

Acting Squadron Leader Gordon Hugh EVERITT, D.F.C. (81032), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 50 Squadron.

Flying Officer Robert Claude HAY (Aus. 407074), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 50 Squadron.

One night in August, 1942, these officers, as captain and navigator of aircraft respectively, were detailed to execute a special bombing sortie. In spite of difficulties, they accomplished their task successfully and brought back excellent photographs. Squadron Leader Everitt and Flying Officer Hay have completed many sorties and they have always displayed great skill and determination to make every mission a success. Their outstanding operational efficiency and devotion to duty have set a fine example.

Bar to Distinguished Flying Cross.

Acting Flying Officer Horace Walter William BERRIDGE, D.F.C. (115634), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 219 Squadron.

Flying Officer Berridge is a highly efficient observer. He has at all times displayed great devotion to duty and set an example worthy of attainment. Since being awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross he has achieved much success.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Squadron Leader George HOWDEN (39738), Reserve of Air Force Officers, No. 68 Squadron.

This officer has been engaged on operational flying since the war began. He has completed numerous sorties and has destroyed at least two enemy aircraft and damaged several others. He is a most capable flight commander and much of the success his flight has achieved can be attributed to Squadron Leader Howden's skilful leadership.

Acting Flight Lieutenant George Albert WILKINS (45120), No. 50 Squadron.

This officer has completed numerous sorties in heavy bombers. On two nights in August, 1942, he captained an aircraft detailed for mine-laying operations of great importance. In spite of adverse weather, Flight Lieutenant Wilkins completed his task successfully. He has also participated in attacks on many highly defended targets and has invariably pressed home his attacks in a very determined manner. He has set an excellent example throughout.

Flying Officer Alec Norman BRISTOW (101502), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 105 Squadron. Pilot Officer Bernard Willis MARSHALL (104775), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 105 Squadron.

On 25th September, 1942, Flying Officer Bristow and Pilot Officer Marshall were pilot and observer respectively of one of a formation of aircraft detailed

to attack the Gestapo Headquarters during the Quisling Rally at Oslo. Whilst over the target area the formation was intercepted by enemy fighters but, evading them, Flying Officer Bristow pressed home his attack and bombed the objective. Throughout, these officers displayed great skill and determination. They constitute an excellent operational crew and have completed many sorties.

Flying Officer Roy Oldfield CALVERT (N.Z.404890), Royal New Zealand Air Force, No. 50 Squadron.

Pilot Officer John Acheson SEARS (Aus.402676), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 50 Squadron.

Flying Officer Calvert and Pilot Officer Sears as pilot and navigator of aircraft respectively have flown together on many sorties. Whatever the weather or the opposition they have always endeavoured to press home their attacks and, on numerous occasions, have obtained excellent photographs. Throughout their tour of duty, these officers have displayed a high standard of skill, together with great devotion to duty.

Flying Officer Cyril Keith SILCOCK (N.Z.411461), Royal New Zealand Air Force, No. 44 (Rhodesia) Squadron.

One night in September, 1942, this officer captained an aircraft detailed to attack an aircraft works in Northern Germany. On arrival at the target area, Flying Officer Silcock descended to only 60 feet and, despite barrage balloons and anti-aircraft fire at point-blank range, he released his incendiary bombs over the objective. Flying Officer Silcock piloted his aircraft through the tops of the flames which rose from burning buildings. The whole fuselage was filled with smoke and pieces of burnt ash. Throughout, this officer displayed high skill and courage. He has completed several sorties all of which have been successful.

These airmen were members of the crew of a heavy bomber detailed for an operational mission one night in September, 1942. Flight Sergeant Campbell was captain and first pilot. The allotted task was completed successfully but, whilst on the return flight, the aircraft was hit by anti-aircraft fire. A shell exploded in the bomb compartment, starting a large fire and setting some flares and distress signals alight. Simultaneously, another shell burst in the nose of the aircraft, shattering the perspex as well as the major portion of the perspex of the pilot's cupola. The resultant rush of air through the aperture swept away all the navigational charts and maps and flung Sergeants Gunnell and Bunclark backwards on to the floor of the aircraft. Both suffered facial burns as did the pilot, the navigator, the wireless operator and the mid-upper gunner. The aircraft became full of smoke and it was attacked by 2 enemy fighters. The pilot could not see his instruments and the aircraft went out of control and fell 2,000 feet before Flight Sergeant Campbell regained control and evaded further attacks by diving and reaching cloud cover. Meanwhile the flames in the fuselage had extended, causing ammunition to explode in all directions. Despite this, Sergeants Corbett, Bunclark and Smith fought their way through the flames to the rear turret to extricate Sergeant Thompson who, despite suffering from a broken leg and being unable to operate his guns, had greatly assisted his captain by reporting the position of the attacking aircraft. Sergeant Coakley, in spite of his injuries, and with amazing skill in the circumstances, established wireless contact with base and continued to obtain bearings throughout the homeward flight. When this country was reached, Flight Sergeant Campbell, who had displayed fine captaincy, resumed the controls and landed the damaged aircraft safely with the undercarriage retracted and without the aid of flaps. Throughout this perilous flight, this gallant crew displayed conduct in keeping with the highest traditions of the Royal Air Force.
