Yetherday Major-General Cornaillon with 5 Battalions of Danish Foot went from hence towards Slefwick, in order, as is supposed, to possess himself of that Place; And we hear, that 3000 Danes are marching towards Diemarfia, upon which the Inhabitants have opened their Sluces, and laid the Country under Water.

Hamburgh, March 23. The Danish Forces which wintered in that part of Holfein that belongs to The Danish Forces which the King of Denmark are all in motion, and have entred into the Duke of Hofficia's Territories. The Danes are firring our several small Frigats at Geluckflad to cruize near the Mouth of the Elbe; which giving a Jealousie to the Suedes in the Dutchy of Bremen, they have reinforced the Garrilons of Leveral Places near the River Elbe. Governor of the Dutchy of Brimin having stopped some Danish Recruits in their Passage from Oldembourg to Holstein, the Danes by way of Reprifal feized a Gentleman of Staden, who was then at Altma; But this Matter is accommodated, and the Gentleman fet at liberty, upon the Governor of Exmen's Promise, That he will suffer the Recruits to continue their March. The Letters from Carelforeene fay, the King of Sueden is come thither from Significant, to see the Squadron of Men of War fitting out in that Port, which will be ready to put to Sea in a very short time.
