Bar to Distinguished Flying Cross.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Frederick Anthony Owen GAZE, D.F.C. (60096), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 616 Squadron.

Since June, 1942, this officer has completed a large number of sorties and has destroyed at least 2 enemy aircraft. By his great skill and fine fighting spirit, Flight Lieutenant Gaze has set an admirable example.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Acting Squadron Leader Herbert James Lempriere Hallows, D.F.M. (45010), No. 165 Squadron.
Squadron Leader Hallows is an outstanding and relentless fighter. He has destroyed 19 and damaged many other enemy aircraft. His skill and under the standard of the many other enemy aircraft. Acting Flight Lieutenant Richard Attwill ELLIS (Can./J.15056), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 412 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron.
