**CENTRAL CHANCERY OF THE ORDERS OF
KNIGHTHOOD.**

St. James's Palace, S.W.1, 29th January, 1943.

The KING has been graciously pleased to give orders for the following appointments to the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, and for the following awards of the British Empire Medal (Military Division):—

To be an Additional Officer of the Military Division of the said Most Excellent Order:—

Acting Squadron Leader Charles James Lofthouse, D.F.C. (60752), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve.

Awarded the British Empire Medal (Military Division):—

1223636 Aircraftman 1st Class John Edward Taylor, Royal Air Force.

1412045 Aircraftman 2nd Class Albert Henry Martin, Royal Air Force.

One night in October, 1942, an aircraft crashed while attempting to land at a Royal Air Force Station, and immediately burst into flames. The petrol tanks were ablaze and ammunition was exploding in all directions. Despite the dangerous conditions Squadron Leader Lofthouse directed the rescue work and, accompanied by Aircraftmen Taylor and Martin who were members of a fire party, repeatedly entered the burning fuselage in an endeavour to rescue the crew. They continued their efforts for over an hour and removed 5 members of the crew from the burning area, but 4 of them unfortunately succumbed to their injuries. Squadron Leader Lofthouse and Aircraftmen Taylor and Martin displayed great energy and a complete disregard for their personal safety.

To be an Additional Member of the Military Division of the said Most Excellent Order:—

Flying Officer Alan James Fuller Eberle (110805), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve.

One day in November, 1942, when 2 aircraft were taking off in formation, the one leading struck another which was standing on the side of the runway, causing it to be thrown into the path of the second aircraft which was taking off. The 3 aircraft caught fire and the pilot of the second aircraft in the formation was stunned and trapped in his cockpit by the hood which had become locked. Fire engines which came to the scene immediately were unable to subdue the flames. At this stage Flying Officer Eberle and an army officer leapt on to the wing but, despite frantic attempts to open the cockpit hood, they were unable to do so before being forced to retire owing to the flames. Seizing an axe these officers returned to

the aircraft, which was burning furiously with ammunition exploding in both wings, and succeeded in smashing a panel. An airman then leaped on to the wing, and with great presence of mind pulled the hood release enabling the 2 officers to extricate the pilot from the blazing aircraft. Flying Officer Eberle and his army companion displayed outstanding courage and complete disregard of their safety in saving the pilot from certain death.

Awarded the British Empire Medal (Military Division):—

1370558 Sergeant Andrew Sangster Donaldson, Royal Air Force.

In October, 1942, this non-commissioned officer was in charge of a bomb dump guard when an aircraft crashed in the vicinity. On hearing the crash, which had occurred about 30 yards away, he called together the guard, collected a fire extinguisher and hurried to the aircraft. He tried to open the doors but found them both jammed. He then moved to the front of the machine and saw one of the occupants hanging by his harness. He climbed through the wreckage and, assisted by one other member of the guard from the outside; with great difficulty extricated the occupant from the harness and wreckage. Meanwhile, escaping petrol and the port engine of the aircraft had burst into flames which considerably increased the difficulties of his task. At this stage he noticed for the first time the other occupant, the pilot of the aircraft, who was lying on his back underneath the wreckage with his head in the flames. Without hesitation, Sergeant Donaldson took off his tunic, and with extreme difficulty, succeeded in covering the head of the pilot; in so doing he sustained burns on the hands and arms. Sergeant Donaldson saw that, alone, he was unable to do more for the pilot, so he turned his attention again to the other member of the crew. He dragged the latter some 20 yards clear of the machine, and attended to him. By this time personnel from the dispersal point arrived and, together with the members of the guard, they succeeded in dragging the wreckage away from the pilot, whose legs were entangled in the controls. He was pulled clear and wrapped in blankets until the arrival of the ambulance.

307737 Leading Aircraftman Harry Denton Hartle, Royal Air Force.

One night in November, 1942, an aircraft which had taken off from an airfield, crashed and burst into flames. Leading Aircraftman Hartle, who was billeted near the scene of the crash, left his home and made his way with considerable difficulty to the burning aircraft. He was the first to arrive on the scene and immediately endeavoured to

render assistance to the crew. The mid-upper gunner was trapped by the legs and was hanging head downwards in his turret which was on fire and surrounded by burning debris. Undeterred by the intense heat and the explosion of ammunition, Leading Aircraftman Hartle, using his own body to shield the injured gunner from the flames, extinguished the fire in the immediate vicinity of his head and succeeded in extricating him before further help arrived. Leading Aircraftman Hartle displayed complete disregard for his own safety and acted in accordance with the highest traditions of the Royal Air Force.

1020475 Aircraftman 1st Class John Henry McNeill, Royal Air Force.

One night in June, 1942, during an enemy attack, a bomb demolished a block of shops and houses and fire broke out owing to escaping gas. The flat asphalt roof was practically intact, lying across the wreckage, and cries for help were coming from underneath. Aircraftman McNeill was among the first to appear on the scene and, joining a volunteer rescue party, burrowed his way underneath the debris. After 3½ hours' work they succeeded in rescuing a number of persons, despite the constant danger from fire and falling debris and the risk of the roof collapsing completely. Throughout, Aircraftman McNeill showed courage, initiative and determination of a high order.

The KING has been graciously pleased to approve the following awards in recognition of gallantry displayed in flying operations against the enemy:—

Distinguished Service Order.

Acting Wing Commander John Kenneth BUCHANAN, D.F.C. (39628), No. 272 Squadron.

This officer has participated in a very large number of sorties, involving bombing attacks against many countries occupied by the enemy. He arrived in Malta in November, 1942, and, within the next 14 days, led his squadron in 6 bombing attacks on enemy shipping. During these operations, Wing Commander Buchanan destroyed 6 enemy aircraft in combat. He is a magnificent leader whose great skill and fine fighting qualities have been of incalculable value.

Bar to Distinguished Flying Cross.

Acting Wing Commander Stanley Bernard GRANT, D.F.C. (33417).

In December, 1942, this officer flew the leading aircraft of a formation acting as escort to a force of fighter bombers. During the flight, 63 enemy air transports escorted by 5 twin-engined fighters were intercepted. Leaving the fighter bombers to attack the transports, Wing Commander Grant led his formation in an attack on the enemy fighters, all of which were shot down. This officer, who displayed great dash, destroyed 2 of them. He has participated in many sorties and, as a result of his outstanding work, much success has been achieved. He has at all times proved himself to be an inspiring and courageous leader.

Acting Squadron Leader Roland Prosper BEAMONT, D.F.C. (41819), No. 609 Squadron.

This officer is an exceptionally skilful and courageous leader. Recently, during a period of 5 weeks his squadron has damaged 22 locomotives and rolling stock and destroyed at least 4 Focke Wulf 190's; 12 of the locomotives were damaged by Squadron Leader Beamont. By his fine fighting qualities and great ability, this officer has contributed in a large measure to the success of the squadron he commands.

Bar to Distinguished Flying Cross.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Edward Lister IFOULD, D.F.C. (Aus.402278), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 109 Squadron.

Squadron Leader Harry Emlay BUFTON (33223), No. 109 Squadron.

One night in January, 1943, Flight Lieutenant Ifould and Squadron Leader Bufton were navigator and captain respectively of an aircraft detailed to lead a bombing force against a target in the Ruhr. Precise timing was essential and these officers, displaying skill of the highest order, achieved their purpose exactly as planned. The following night, Flight Lieutenant Ifould and Squadron Leader Bufton faultlessly completed another sortie in similar circumstances.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Robert SEED (106646), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 249 Squadron.

This officer has participated in a large number of sorties, including many fighter bomber operations. One morning in November, 1942, he destroyed a Messerschmitt 109 off the coast of Sicily. During the afternoon he bombed the airfield at Gela, obtaining hits on a hangar. The next day despite heavy opposing fire he successfully attacked Comiso airfield. Flight Lieutenant Seed has made many low flying attacks on airfields and has destroyed at least 4 enemy aircraft on the ground. He is a skilful and determined pilot, whose courageous example has been worthy of high praise.

Flying Officer Kervin Charles BEETON (Aus.407162), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 10 (R.A.A.F.) Squadron.

Flying Officer Robert George BOWLEY (Aus.416015), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 10 (R.A.A.F.) Squadron.

In January, 1943, Flying Officers Beeton and Bowley were captain and navigator of a Sunderland aircraft which located an enemy merchant ship attempting to evade the blockade. Despite extremely adverse weather, Flying Officer Beeton displayed outstanding determination and maintained patrol over the area until one of our naval vessels arrived and engaged the enemy vessel. On reaching a base in this country, Flying Officer Beeton effected a masterly emergency landing in very difficult circumstances. Throughout Flying Officer Bowley displayed brilliant navigation which contributed materially to the success of the operation. Both these officers have always displayed courage and devotion to duty of a high order.

Flying Officer Arthur HODGSON (119292), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 502 Squadron.

In January, 1943, this officer captained an aircraft detailed for a shipping reconnaissance. In spite of extremely adverse weather he succeeded in locating an enemy merchant ship attempting to run the blockade. He made several attacking runs over the ship but visibility was so poor that he was unable to complete his attack. Nevertheless, he flew over the objective for an hour and a quarter, shadowing it most effectively. He eventually landed his aircraft at base with fuel sufficient for only a further 15 minutes flying. Throughout, this officer displayed great courage, persistence and devotion to duty.

Flying Officer Allan William Russell TRIGGS, M.B.E. (Aus.400500), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 172 Squadron.

Pilot Officer Colin BADHAM (Aus.403467), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 172 Squadron.

One night in October, 1942, Flying Officer Triggs and Pilot Officer Badham were pilot and navigator respectively of an aircraft which attacked successfully a U-boat in the Bay of Biscay. In the same area, one night in January, 1943, they again executed a determined attack, in bad weather, on another enemy submarine. A few nights later, Flying Officer Triggs displayed fine airmanship when, during an anti-submarine patrol, a propeller and reduction gear broke adrift and caused the entire engine to fall into the sea. Despite this, he flew the aircraft back to this country and landed it safely. Both these officers have always displayed courage and ability of a high standard.

Pilot Officer Alfred Francis FOSTER (126581), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 161 Squadron.

This officer has completed numerous sorties and has acted as captain of aircraft on 30 occasions. He has at all times displayed exceptional deter-

mination and initiative. This was amply demonstrated one night in December, 1942, when he completed an important sortie in the most adverse weather.

Pilot Officer Donald Gillespie MERCER (130463), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 122 Squadron.

This officer, who has participated in numerous sorties, has led his section and occasionally the flight, with skill and courage. He has destroyed 3 enemy aircraft, 1 motor torpedo boat and shared in the destruction of 2 other motor torpedo boats. Throughout, Pilot Officer Mercer has set a fine example.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

1141383 Flight Sergeant John William KING, No. 144 Squadron.

In December, 1942, this airman captained 1 of a small formation of aircraft which attacked 2 merchant vessels and an armed ship off the Norwegian coast. In the face of heavy opposing fire, Flight Sergeant King pressed home his attack and obtained a hit on one of the merchant ships. It was subsequently learned that the vessel was destroyed. This airman has at all times displayed outstanding operational efficiency and sets a fine example.
