Bar to Distinguished Flying Cross.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Frederick Denzil James THOMPSON, D.F.C. (120392), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 7 Squadron.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Acting Wing Commander Thomas Gilbert MAHADDIE, D.S.O., A.F.C. (44456), No. 7 Squadron.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

517088 Flight Sergeant Charles STEWART, No. 7 Squadron.

One night in February, 1943, Wing Commander Mahaddie, Flight Lieutenant Thompson and Flight Sergeant Stewart were captain, navigator and flight engineer respectively of an aircraft detailed to attack Cologne. Whilst over the target area the aircraft was hit by anti-aircraft fire and attacked by an enemy fighter. The bomber sustained much damage. The aileron control cables were severed, causing the aircraft to fall into a steep diving turn and the wireless apparatus and the inter communication system were rendered unserviceable. By skilful use of the engines, Wing Commander Mahaddie regained control and set

course for home. With great promptitude, Flight Sergeant Stewart inspected the damage and, after reporting the position to his captain, rendered first aid to the wireless operator who had sustained a severe wound in the hand. Flight Sergeant Stewart then did all in his power to assist his captain in flying the aircraft back to base which was gained at the estimated time due to the superb navigation of Flight Lieutenant Thompson. In the face of trying circumstances, these members of aircraft crew displayed great courage, skill and initiative.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Flight Lieutenant Desmond Malcolm ROLPH SMITH (36249).

This officer has completed a large number of hours operational flying, involving some long and arduous flights over mountainous areas, often in extremely adverse weather. Throughout he has displayed great skill, fortitude and unflagging devotion to duty.

Flight Lieutenant John Stuart TAYLOR (60090), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 145 Squadron.

Flight Lieutenant Taylor is a skilful and tenacious fighter. One day in January, 1943, he led his section in an attack on 10 Macchi 200s, regardless of the fact that these were supported by another formation of enemy fighters. During the engagement 2 enemy aircraft were destroyed, 1 of them by Flight Lieutenant Taylor. This officer, who has set a most inspiring example, has destroyed 3 and shared in the destruction of 2 more enemy aircraft.

Captain Charles Leonard FOULDS (P.103337), South African Air Force, No. 40 Squadron.

This officer has completed numerous reconnaissances over the Western Desert and Libya, displaying sound judgment and great skill throughout. His fine leadership, courage and unflinching devotion to duty have proved an inspiration to the flight he commands.

Flying Officer Cedric Rossall HESKETH (N.Z.11404), Royal New Zealand Air Force, No. 145 Squadron.

One day in January, 1943, this officer participated in an engagement against a force of enemy aircraft. During the fight his commanding officer's aircraft developed engine trouble. Flying Officer Hesketh, displaying great determination, covered the disabled aircraft until its pilot brought it safely down on to the sea. He then attacked the enemy force and shot down 2 aircraft within 2 minutes. Throughout he displayed great courage and tenacity.

Lieutenant Eric Ian Humphries STURGEON (P.103236), South African Air Force, No. 40 Squadron.

This officer has completed numerous reconnaissances. On one occasion he piloted 1 of 2 aircraft which were intercepted by 4 Italian fighters. In the ensuing engagement 2 enemy aircraft were shot down, 1 of them by Lieutenant Sturgeon. On another occasion, in the El Ajamein area, his aircraft was attacked by 8 enemy aircraft but he damaged 1 of them before his own aircraft was shot down. During the fight, Lieutenant Sturgeon was wounded in the neck. Throughout this officer has displayed fine leadership, great determination and devotion to duty.

Pilot Officer Aubrey Hehry Herbert JENKINS (134351), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve.

This officer has taken part in very many operational missions. Throughout he has displayed exceptional navigational skill and achieved success in circumstances in which any lack of resource would have proved disastrous. He has won the entire confidence of all with whom he has flown.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

Aus. 403360 Flight Sergeant John McFARLANE, Royal Australian Air Force, No. 450 (R.A.A.F.) Squadron.

In operations in the Western Desert, this pilot has displayed great keenness and determination. He has participated in many sorties, involving low bombing and machine gun attacks and fighter escorts. In addition to destroying 1 enemy aircraft in combat, Flight Sergeant McFarlane has inflicted considerable damage to enemy targets on the ground. His skilful leadership and fine fighting qualities have set a praiseworthy example.

Can/R.70100 Flight Sergeant Cedric Stanley MARSH, Royal Canadian Air Force.

As air gunner, Flight Sergeant Marsh has completed a large number of operational missions. Throughout, he has displayed great determination and devotion to duty and has proved himself to be a valuable member of aircraft crew.

Can/R.84748 Flight Sergeant Murray Edward WHITE, Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 156 Squadron.

One night in February, 1943, Flight Sergeant White was the pilot of an aircraft detailed to attack Turin. Whilst over the target area, the aircraft was hit by anti-aircraft fire. A large splinter damaged the main plane and the port inner tank, causing 1 engine to fail. On the return journey, when crossing the Alps, all movable equipment was jettisoned in an effort to maintain height. Much petrol was lost but displaying superb airmanship and great tenacity, Flight Sergeant White flew the damaged aircraft back to this country with 1 engine out of action. His great skill and courage set a fine example.

996639 Sergeant William McLEAN, No. 7 Squadron.

One night in December, 1942, Sergeant McLean was the rear gunner of an aircraft detailed to attack a target in the Rhineland. During the operation the aircraft was hit by anti-aircraft fire, which rendered the rear turret unserviceable. Unperturbed, Sergeant McLean operated the turret manually and, when the aircraft was attacked by an enemy fighter, his courageous conduct was worthy of high praise.

Aus. 411251 Sergeant Neil Frank MOSES, Royal Australian Air Force, No. 178 Squadron.

Sergeant Moses was the rear gunner of an aircraft which in January, 1943, was detailed to attack Tripoli by night. When nearing the target the aircraft was subjected to anti-aircraft fire. A shell burst in the rear compartment slightly wounding Sergeant Moses and causing small arms ammunition to explode. Pyrotechnics were in danger of becoming ignited but Sergeant Moses, displaying great coolness and initiative, succeeded in jettisoning them. In the face of a trying situation, this airman displayed great resource and rendered valuable assistance to his captain.
