attacked by a Focke Wulf 190 but although his aircraft was damaged, he successfully evaded the attacker and landed safely at base. On another attacker and landed safely at base. On another occasion he persevered with a search despite heavy occasion he persevered with a search despite heavy fire from the German ground defences. In Feb-ruary, 1943, he flew to within 5 miles of Le Treport, brought his aircraft down on to the sea and rescued a Canadian pilot who had been shot down 3 hours previously. The visibility was de-teriorating fast but he succeeded in a rescue which typified the skill, courage and resourcefulness invariably exhibited by this officer.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Hugh Drummond Venables (106029), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 418 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron.

This officer has taken part in 29 sorties, including a number of attacks on airfields in Holland; Belgium and France. In attacks on lines of communication and installations, Flight Lieutenant Venables has damaged numerous lecomotives and Venables has damaged numerous locomotives and storage tanks by machine gun fire. His inspiring leadership, great ability and outstanding devotion to duty have contributed materially to the high standard of operational efficiency of his flight.

Flying Officer John Michael BRYAN (102570), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. i37 Squadron:
This officer has taken part in a large number of sorties and patrols. On 1 occasion he assisted in the destruction of a Dornier 217. In attacks on enemy transport in Northern France and Belgium, Flying Officer Bryan has damaged 15 locomotives. His skill and keenness have been worthy of high praise

praise.

Pilot Officer Edward Lester GIMBEL (Can/J.15890), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 403 (R.C.A.F.)

This officer has taken part in a very large number of sorties over enemy territory, including a number as escort to heavy bombers.
