To be an Additional Officer of the Military Division of the said Most Excellent Order:—

Acting Squadron Leader Geoffrey Wilson O'Neill Fisher, D.F.C. (42560), Royal Air Force.

To be an Additional Member of the Military Division of the said Most Excellent Order:—

Pilot Officer Farnham Hill, D.F.C. (134661), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve.

Awarded the British Empire Medal (Military Division):—

1544738 Leading Aircraftman Arthur George Miles, Royal Air Force.

1047210 Aircraftman 2nd Class Herbert Fletcher, Royal Air Force.

One night in February, 1943, a bomber aircraft crashed in a field on return from an operational flight during which damage had been sustained to the elevator controls. The aircraft broke in two at the rear of the mid-upper turret, and the whole wreckage caught fire. Five members of the crew were able to step out through the gap where the fracture took place, whilst the pilot escaped through his window. Squadron Leader Fisher and Pilot Officer Hill, who had both landed in another aircraft just before the crash, having been on a sortie of 5½ hours' duration, were in the immediate vicinity and rushed to the aircraft. Aircraftman Fletcher, who was on duty with the airfield controller, and Leading Aircraftman Miles, who was engaged at a dispersal point some 100 yards away, also hurried to the scene. Aircraftman Fletcher was the first to arrive and he entered the fuselage, thinking that all members of the crew had been trapped therein. He was joined by Squadron Leader Fisher and Leading Aircraftman Miles, but owing to the intense heat, all were forced to retire. The flight engineer was then found hanging from the pilot's window and unable to move owing to a broken thigh. Aircraftman Fletcher climbed along the port wing in order to render assistance to him. Squadron Leader Fisher, Pilot Officer Hill and Leading Aircraftman Miles all helped, the work being directed by Squadron Leader Fisher. Despite the intense heat and the danger from exploding petrol tanks and ammunition they succeeded in extricating the flight engineer, who had been

trapped in the pilot's cockpit. The initiative and heroic efforts displayed by these officers and airmen undoubtedly saved their comrade's life.

To be an Additional Officer of the Military Division of the said Most Excellent Order:—

Acting Squadron Leader Frederick Thomas Moore, B.S., F.R.C.S., L.R.C.P. (23417), Reserve of Air Force Officers.

Awarded the British Empire Medal (Military Division).

1479714 Leading Aircraftman Beric Vaughan Icke, Royal Air Force.

One night in March, 1943, an aircraft crashed on a Royal Air Force Station and immediately burst into flames. Squadron Leader Moore (the duty medical officer) saw the accident and, accompanied by Leading Aircraftman Icke, a medical orderly, proceeded to the scene. Squadron Leader Moore directed the removal of the rear gunner, who was dazed and sitting amongst the burning wreckage, to a place of safety. The aircraft was now enveloped in flames and ammunition was exploding. Nevertheless, despite the intense heat and the danger from exploding oxygen bottles this officer and airman entered the burning wreckage in an attempt to rescue another member of the crew who was pinned down. Without any protective clothing they lifted aside the burning wreckage and, with great difficulty, succeeded in extricating the injured man. Squadron Leader Moore rendered first aid to the rescued man. Squadron Leader Moore sustained burns to his chest and hands in carrying out the operation. This officer and airman both displayed courage and devotion to duty in keeping with the highest traditions of the Royal Air Force.

To be an Additional Member of the Military Division of the said Most Excellent Order:—

Flying Officer Edwin Morgan (118683), Royal Air Force.

Awarded the British Empire Medal (Military Division).

1635851 Aircraftman 1st Class Joseph Pickering, Royal Air Force.

One day in January, 1943, Flying Officer Morgan and Aircraftman Pickering were master and nursing orderly respectively of the air/sea rescue pinnacle which was repeatedly attacked by enemy aircraft from very close range. During the first attack Flying Officer Morgan's left elbow was shattered by shell splinters and a bullet passed through his right calf. The shock rendered him unconscious for a time. Aircraftman Pickering was also

wounded and in subsequent attacks one member of the crew was killed and six others were wounded. Immediately he regained consciousness Flying Officer Morgan, refusing medical aid until all other members had been treated, resumed his position commanding the vessel and directed defensive measures. Aircraftman Pickering, although suffering great pain, continued to tend other injured members of the crew. Throughout the action Flying Officer Morgan and Aircraftman Pickering conducted themselves with great courage, skill and resource. The excellent example set by this officer and airman inspired and encouraged the other members of the crew during the return of their sinking vessel.

To be an Additional Member of the Military Division of the said Most Excellent Order:—

Flying Officer Raymond Kitchener Weston (124832), Royal Air Force.

In January, 1943, this officer was the pilot of a Beaufighter aircraft which swung off the runway and hit an obstruction which caused the aircraft to catch fire. Flying Officer Weston managed to extricate himself and immediately went to the aid of the observer who was trapped in the blazing aircraft. Cannon gun ammunition was exploding, the flames were spreading and there was a very grave danger of the petrol tanks exploding. Nevertheless, with the assistance of 3 workmen, who were nearby when the accident occurred, Flying Officer Weston with bare hands, pulled the wreckage apart and dragged the observer to safety. Ten seconds later the aircraft was a complete mass of flames. Flying Officer Weston's courage and initiative undoubtedly saved his companion's life.

To be an Additional Member of the Military Division of the said Most Excellent Order:—

Pilot Officer Keith James Hall (134744), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve.

Awarded the British Empire Medal (Military Division).

1515644 Leading Aircraftman Ian Joseph McCrae, Royal Air Force.

One morning in February, 1943, a Tiger Moth aircraft collided with a stationary aircraft and burst into flames immediately. Pilot Officer Hall and Leading Aircraftman McCrae, who were in another aircraft taxiing along the boundary of a nearby airfield, witnessed the accident and immediately ran to the scene in an endeavour to rescue the pilot who had been rendered unconscious. Pilot Officer Hall and Leading Aircraftman McCrae succeeded in unfastening the pilot's harness and were then driven back by the flames. Displaying complete disregard for their personal safety this officer and airman climbed on to the fuselage and re-entered the flames. The starboard wing was burnt out and the wreckage heeled over, throwing McCrae to the ground. Nevertheless he renewed his efforts and assisted Pilot Officer Hall in dragging the unconscious pilot to safety. This officer and airman displayed high courage.

1281343 Sergeant Sidney Peter Johnson, Royal Air Force.

One day in January, 1943, Sergeant Johnson was the pilot of a Master aircraft which crashed and burst into flames after taking off. Sergeant Johnson, although suffering from a broken leg, severe facial burns and with his clothing on fire, managed to extricate himself from the burning wreckage. The petrol tanks were ablaze and likely to explode at any moment, but, knowing that his instructor was trapped in the cockpit, Sergeant Johnson returned to the aircraft and, despite his injuries, succeeded in releasing his companion. This heroic act undoubtedly saved the instructor's life.

552166 Corporal Gerard James McQuaide, Royal Air Force.

1102677 Leading Aircraftman Sam Halstead, Royal Air Force.

One evening in October, 1942, during an enemy air attack, a fire occurred in an aircraft. Knowing the aircraft to be loaded with bombs, these airmen attempted to release the bombs while the aircraft was burning. Being unable to do so they obtained a fire extinguisher and persisted in their efforts to extinguish the fire until ordered to cease. The bombs exploded a few minutes later.

During the whole of this time enemy bombs were falling in the vicinity. Corporal McQuaide and Leading Aircraftman Halstead have, at all times, displayed a high standard of efficiency, courage and devotion to duty.

96274 Air Corporal Jack Friedman, South African Air Force.

In December, 1942, whilst being driven to his aircraft, Air Corporal Friedman observed an aircraft on fire coming in to land. When touching down the aircraft overturned and trapped the pilot in his seat. Air Corporal Friedman rushed to the scene and, while others raised the wing, he endeavoured to rescue the pilot. To do this it was necessary to unstrap the parachute. As he took this off flames entered the cockpit. Although fully aware of the danger from petrol tanks catching fire Air Corporal Friedman, displaying courage and initiative, succeeded in dragging the pilot clear. His gallant action undoubtedly saved the pilot's life.

1164525 Leading Aircraftman Cecil Arthur Layton, Royal Air Force.

One afternoon in October, 1942, a transport aircraft crashed and in the resulting fire was totally destroyed, its 13 occupants being killed. Leading Aircraftman Layton, who was working in the kitchen of the officers' mess, unhesitatingly ran to the burning aircraft and attempted to rescue the occupants. In the face of an inferno of flame and the danger of exploding petrol tanks and flying fragments, this airman, after several attempts, succeeded in dragging a body from the burning wreckage. In so doing he sustained severe burns and had to be removed to hospital. The courageous conduct of Leading Aircraftman Layton on this occasion is worthy of the highest praise.

The KING has been graciously pleased to approve the award of the George Medal to:—

1277194 Aircraftman 2nd Class George Graham Layton, Royal Air Force.

One afternoon in July, 1942, an aircraft crashed on the edge of an airfield and burst into flames. The fire tender arrived on the scene almost immediately but was forced to withdraw to a distance of about 100 yards as the aircraft was burning fiercely and the bombs were still on board. Aircraftman Layton, on being informed that one member of the crew (the front gunner) was still in the aircraft, immediately ran back and climbed on to the wing. He assisted the gunner, whose clothing was alight, to get clear of the wreckage and stripped him of his burning clothing. Aircraftman Layton then took off his own shirt and wrapped the airman in it and assisted him to the fire tender just before the bombs exploded. Aircraftman Layton displayed courage and gallantry of the highest order.

ROYAL AIR FORCE.

The KING has been graciously pleased to approve the following awards in recognition of gallantry displayed in flying operations against the enemy:—

Distinguished Service Order.

Wing Commander John Marlow THOMPSON, D.F.C. (34183), Reserve of Air Force Officers.

This officer has a fine operational record. He fought in France and later took part in the Battle of Britain. For the past 9 months he has been engaged in flying operations from Malta, playing a prominent part in the defence of the island during a period of intense air attacks. Latterly, Wing Commander Thompson has led formations of fighter bombers in numerous successful attacks against port installations, factories, airfields and other targets. By his great skill and brilliant leadership, Wing Commander Thompson has contributed in a large measure to the excellent results obtained.

Lieutenant-Colonel Douglas Haig LOFTUS, D.F.C., South African Air Force.

This officer has completed much operational flying, having fought in Abyssinia and in the earlier

campaign in the Western Desert. Since the fighting at El Alamein, Lieutenant-Colonel Loftus has taken part in 35 sorties; displaying great skill and brilliant leadership throughout. By his personal example he has imbued a fine fighting spirit throughout the wing which has been responsible for many destructive attacks on the enemy's ground forces. Lieutenant-Colonel Loftus has destroyed 3 enemy aircraft.

Squadron Leader Ronald Bain THOMSON (90370), Auxiliary Air Force, No. 172 Squadron.

During recent anti-submarine operations, this officer has achieved several successes. Towards the end of March, 1943, he successfully attacked a U-boat and, 3 days later he accomplished a similar feat. On the latter occasion he pressed home his attack in the face of heavy opposing fire, straddling the U-boat with his depth charges. One night in April, 1943, Squadron Leader Thomson successfully attacked an enemy submarine with depth charges and, some 20 minutes later he attacked another one with machine-gun fire. This officer has displayed exceptional skill and devotion to duty, setting an inspiring example to the squadron he commands.

Acting Squadron Leader John Ronald URWIN-MANN, D.F.C. (42281), No. 126 Squadron.

Within the past 6 months, whilst operating from Malta this officer has completed a large number of sorties, involving attacks on factories, warehouses, port installations, power stations and airfields in Sicily and nearby enemy islands. On 1 occasion he led a formation which attacked an airfield and destroyed many aircraft on the ground; Squadron Leader Urwin-Mann also obtained a hit on a petrol installation, causing a violent explosion and a large fire. Another of his successes was the destruction of a portion of the main railway line during a sortie at Gela in January, 1943. During the same operation, Squadron Leader Urwin-Mann engaged a Messerschmitt 210, shooting away its starboard engine. By his great skill and inspiring leadership this officer has raised his squadron to a high pitch of fighting efficiency.

Distinguished Service Order.

Pilot Officer Raymond John HOPKINS (129481), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 466 (R.A.A.F.) Squadron.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Flying Officer Reginald Francis CLAYTON (121139), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 466 (R.A.A.F.) Squadron.

Conspicuous Gallantry Medal (flying).

846405 Sergeant Edward Francis HICKS, Auxiliary Air Force, No. 466 (R.A.A.F.) Squadron.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

1126195 Sergeant Frederick Charles BLAIR, No. 466 (R.A.A.F.) Squadron.

In April, 1943, Pilot Officer Hopkins, Flying Officer Clayton and Sergeants Hicks and Blair were air bomber, navigator, captain and wireless operator respectively of an aircraft detailed to attack a target in the Ruhr. Over Germany the aircraft was attacked by an enemy fighter. The first burst of fire from the attacker fatally injured the rear gunner and wounded the air bomber, navigator and wireless operator. The fighter made a second attack but Sergeant Hicks avoided its gunfire by turning steeply under the enemy aircraft which was not seen again. Although the hydraulic and brake systems of the bomber were damaged, causing the wheels to drop down and the bomb doors to open, the crew decided to continue their mission. Pilot Officer Hopkins, the air bomber, although suffering from a compound fracture of the arm and, at times, only retaining consciousness with great difficulty, displayed unsurpassed determination by directing his pilot to the target and bombing it successfully. On the return flight, Pilot Officer Hopkins, Flying Officer Clayton and Sergeant Blair laboured for more than 2 hours to assist the mortally wounded rear gunner, extricating him from his turret and administering morphia; some of their efforts were made whilst flying at 15,000 feet and without oxygen. Sergeant Hicks eventually flew the damaged aircraft to an airfield in this country, where he effected a landing without the aid of flaps. These members of aircraft crew displayed great courage, fortitude and determination in most hazardous circumstances.

Bar to Distinguished Flying Cross.

Acting Squadron Leader Ian Radnor STEPHENS, D.F.C. (81915), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 162 Squadron.

This officer has completed 72 operational missions. One night in March, 1943, his aircraft was subjected to a series of attacks by an enemy fighter. Although much damage was sustained and the rear gunner killed, Squadron Leader Stephens resolutely held course until his purpose was accomplished. Displaying great skill he flew the damaged aircraft safely to base. Squadron Leader Stephens displayed great courage and devotion to duty in the execution of a hazardous task.

Flying Officer Nevil Everard REEVES, D.F.C. (110797), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 89 Squadron.

This officer is a most skilful and courageous pilot. In operations in the Middle East he has displayed exceptional keenness and great powers of endurance. Flying Officer Reeves has destroyed 9 enemy aircraft at night.

Warrant Officer Arthur Alexander O'LEARY, D.F.C., D.F.M. (630959), No. 89 Squadron.

Warrant Officer O'Leary is an observer of exceptional merit. He has invariably displayed great courage and keenness and has taken part in the destruction of 14 enemy aircraft at night.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Flight Lieutenant Victor Charles LOVELL (85649), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 89 Squadron.

This officer has completed much operational flying and has displayed courage, keenness and devotion to duty throughout. Whilst operating from Malta he has undertaken numerous sorties over enemy territory. In other operations he has destroyed 3 enemy aircraft.

Acting Flight Lieutenant James Stewart FRAME (N.Z.41982), Royal New Zealand Air Force, No. 221 Squadron.

This officer has completed 52 sorties, including numerous successful shipping reconnaissances. One of these in October, 1942, enabled a formation to make a successful attack on a convoy of merchant vessels and their escort. During a flight in February, 1943, he located 4 separate convoys. In spite of fierce opposition from escorting destroyers, Flight Lieutenant Frame shadowed the convoys which were later attacked by following aircraft. In April, 1943, he was detailed for a shipping search in the Trapani/Palermo area and located a convoy of 4 merchant ships escorted by 6 destroyers and 5 other vessels. Despite heavy fire from the convoy, Flight Lieutenant Frame shadowed and reported the position of the convoys which were subsequently attacked successfully. This officer has displayed outstanding skill and great courage, and rendered most valuable service.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Thomas Sidney LEA (109093), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve (since missing), No. 77 Squadron.

One night in April, 1943, this officer captained an aircraft detailed to attack Frankfurt. Whilst still many miles from the target, on the outward flight, 1 of the engines in the aircraft became unserviceable. In spite of this, Flight Lieutenant Lea continued to the target and pressed home his attack. Whilst over the target area the bomber was hit in the wings, fuselage and astro-dome by anti-aircraft fire. Displaying great skill, Flight Lieutenant Lea flew the damaged bomber back to this country. In the face of adverse circumstances, this officer displayed great courage and devotion to duty. On other occasions his fine airmanship has ensured the safe return of his aircraft in difficult circumstances.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Ian Hardy Robertson SHAND (80102), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 145 Squadron.

This officer has taken part in 100 sorties. During a recent flight he flew the leading aircraft of a section in support of ground forces. South of El Hamma, 12 enemy aircraft were encountered and engaged. In the ensuing combats, Flight Lieutenant Shand's aircraft was attacked by 8 enemy aircraft. Displaying great skill and resolution he fought his way clear and in so doing shot down 1 of the attackers, although his own aircraft was hit in many places and temporarily went out of control. Flight Lieutenant Shand succeeded in regaining control, however, and flew

the damaged aircraft to base. This officer who has destroyed 2 enemy aircraft has set a praiseworthy example.

Flying Officer Kenneth John LOVELESS (123587), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 104 Squadron.

During an operational flight one night in April, 1943, this officer displayed courage and skill of a high order. When nearing the target area 1 of the engines of his aircraft failed but, undeterred, he flew on and bombed his objective accurately. Displaying superb airmanship he flew the damaged aircraft more than 250 miles over the sea to reach friendly territory and make a safe landing at an emergency airfield. By his skill and determination, this officer was responsible for the safe return of the aircraft and its crew.

Pilot Officer John Henry Low (N.Z.404611), Royal New Zealand Air Force, No. 39 Squadron.

As wireless operator/air gunner this officer has flown on 30 sorties, 23 of them from Malta. In April, 1943, he was a member of the crew of 1 of a formation of aircraft which attacked a convoy of 4 merchant ships escorted by 11 destroyers and fighter aircraft. During the run-in his aircraft was attacked by 3 Italian fighters but skilful return fire by Pilot Officer Low frustrated the attackers, thus enabling his pilot to successfully attack 1 of the merchant vessels. On 2 previous occasions, during air attacks on enemy convoys, his excellent work has contributed materially to the successes achieved. His example of courage and devotion to duty has proved most inspiring.

Pilot Officer Geoffrey Winston WOODWARD (139497), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 51 Squadron.

One night in April, 1943, this officer was the captain of a bomber detailed to attack Stettin. On the outward flight, whilst still a considerable distance from the target, 1 of the engines failed. Despite this, Pilot Officer Woodward continued his flight to the target which he ultimately bombed successfully. Displaying superb airmanship he flew the bomber to base on 3 engines and effected a perfect landing. By his great skill, courage and dogged determination, this officer set a most inspiring example.

Warrant Officer Anthony John EDGAR (957468), No. 89 Squadron.

Warrant Officer Edgar has an excellent operational record. He took part in many sorties whilst based in the United Kingdom before proceeding to the Middle East where he has fought in Libya, Malta, and Tripolitania. He is an observer of great skill and has taken part in the destruction of 6 enemy aircraft. Warrant Officer Edgar has set a commendable example.

Warrant Officer Harold VERTICAN (565380), No. 462 (R.A.A.F.) Squadron.

Warrant Officer Vertican has completed 40 sorties, involving attacks on targets in Greece, Crete and North Africa. He is a keen and skilful pilot whose determination to achieve success has set a fine example. On 1 occasion he captained an aircraft detailed to attack Leros. The objective was successfully bombed but, whilst still over the target area, 1 engine of his aircraft became unservicable. Despite this, he flew the bomber back to base. Owing to the presence of thick fog, which covered a wide area, Warrant Officer Vertican was unable to make a landing. Undeterred, he flew on searching for another landing ground. The situation became serious and all moveable equipment was jettisoned to assist in maintaining height. Warrant Officer Vertican eventually made a landing after a flight of more than 700 miles with 1 of the aircraft's 2 engines out of action. He displayed great courage and superb airmanship in very trying circumstances.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

Can/R.75287 Flight Sergeant Walter William DRECHSLER, Royal Canadian Air Force No. 150 Squadron.

In most hazardous circumstances this airman displayed courage and fortitude worthy of the highest praise during air operations.

Aus.406247 Flight Sergeant Edward Charles House, Royal Australian Air Force, No. 450 (R.A.A.F.) Squadron.

This airman has taken part in many attacks on enemy troop concentrations and transport, bombing and machine-gunning them from a low level.

During a recent sortie, an aircraft of the formation in which Flight Sergeant House was flying was badly damaged by anti-aircraft fire. Displaying great determination he escorted the damaged aircraft until its pilot was compelled to make a crash-landing. By attacking everything in the vicinity of the crashed aircraft with machine gun fire, Flight Sergeant House proved of great assistance to his comrade who was thus enabled to dash to our lines in safety. This airman has displayed great courage and a fine fighting spirit.

778881 Sergeant Gustav OLSSON, No. 162 Squadron.

This airman has completed 27 sorties. One night in March, 1943, he was the front gunner of an aircraft engaged on an operational flight off the Italian coast. During the operation the aircraft was attacked by an enemy aircraft and the rear gunner was fatally injured. Sergeant Olsson made his way to the rear but was unable to extricate the rear gunner from the turret which had been rendered unservicable. He succeeded in moving his comrade's body a little to one side, however, and thus was able to observe and report the movements of 3 hostile aircraft flying in to attack. His commentary enabled the pilot to take effective evading action. Sergeant Olsson's cool and courageous conduct contributed materially to the safe return of the aircraft.

Aus.416288 Sergeant James Chadd RUDD, Royal Australian Air Force, No. 78 Squadron.

One night in April, 1943, this airman captained an aircraft detailed to attack Stettin. On the outward flight, some 200 miles from the target, 1 engine of his aircraft was damaged by anti-aircraft fire and became unservicable. In spite of this, Sergeant Rudd flew on to the objective bombed it successfully and flew the aircraft back to base. On this, his first operational flight over enemy territory, Sergeant Rudd displayed skill, tenacity and devotion to duty worthy of great praise.
