One night in April, 1943, this airman captained an aircraft which attacked Duisburg. On the return flight, the bomber was attacked by an enemy fighter and sustained damage. Sergeant Broadbent was wounded in the hand and shoulder but, displaying great skill, he evaded the attacker and flew the damaged bomber to base. Although the starboard and tail wheel tyres were punctured, and the hydraulic system were punctured, and the hydraulic system damaged, Sergeant Broadbent landed the aircraft safely. This airman displayed skill and courage worthy of high praise.

N.Z.414263 Sergeant Herbert James Dalzell, Royal New Zealand Air Force, No. 75 (N.Z.) Squadron. One night in April, 1943, this airman was the pilot of an aircraft which participated in an attack on Rostock. On the return flight, some 400 miles from base, the aircraft came into collision with from base, the aircraft came into collision with another aircraft, overtaking from the rear. Damage was sustained to the fin and rudder, causing temporary loss of control. Skilfully and confidently, Sergeant Dalzell regained control and kept to his course. Several attempts were made to straighten the fin but they proved unavailing. Despite this, Sergeant Dalzell flew the aircraft back to base. This airman, who has completed many sorties, has invariably displayed great skill, courage and determination.

Sergeant Frederick John Parkinson,

No. 600 Squadron.
On one occasion in April, 1943, this airman was engaged on a patrol. When returning to base, although a considerable distance out over the sea, attnough a considerable distance out over the sea, attnough a considerable distance out over the sea, the saw an enemy aircraft approaching head on in the early light of the dawn. A running fight ensued, lasting for 35 minutes. During the engagement the enemy aircraft took violent evasive action but, displaying great determination and accurate deflection shooting, Sergeant Parkins on eventually shot the enemy aircraft down. In the accurate denection shooting, Sergeant Parkinson eventually shot the enemy aircraft down. In the combat, 'such was his tenacity that, when the aircraft were approaching each other head on, Sergeant Parkinson would not deviate and forced his adversary to do so. This airman eventually landed at base, having only a few gallons of petrol left in each tank. He has invariably displayed fine fighting qualities and outstanding devotion to duty. devotion to duty.

One night in April, 1943, Sergeants Huntley and Stott were pilot and rear gunner of an aircraft detailed to attack Stettin. Whilst over enemy territory the aircraft was attacked by 3 enemy fighters. In the ensuing engagement Sergeant Stott, skilfully using his guns, drove off 2 of the attackers and shot the other one down in flames. The bomber had sustained much damage, however, making it difficult to control. Despite this, Sergeant Huntley flew the aircraft back to an airfield in this country, making a successful landing without the aid of flares. Both these members of the crew displayed great skill and resolution, setting a fine example. resolution, setting a fine example.
